

Wyomissing Hills Pool Rules and Regulations

In order to ensure a safe environment for our members and guests, the following rules are in effect and will be enforced at all times. Please review these rules with your family and guests before coming to the pool.

- Obey all life guards and staff members.
- No one may be in the water without a lifeguard on duty at the poolside.
- No diving in shallow water and areas marked "NO DIVING".
- No water wings and flotation devices in the diving well or on the slide
- Only one person is allowed on the diving boards and slide at one time, this includes the stairs. Swimmers must go down the slide feet first on their backs.
- No catching swimmers going down the slide.
- Proper swimsuit attire must be worn in the pool, no street clothing allowed.
- Water approved toys only in the pool. No water balloons, hard balls, etc
- No hanging or swimming on the ropes or lane lines.
- No swimming in the lap lane unless you are swimming laps.
- Do not sit on, lean on or plug the baby pool fountain.
- Children older than 6 years of age are not permitted in the baby pool.
- ALL children in the baby pool must be under direct and active supervision of an adult at all times.
- Swim diapers must be worn by children who are not potty trained. No regular diapers allowed.
- No running, pushing or horse play.
- No profanity.
- No glass containers allowed anywhere.
- No alcoholic beverages at any time.
- No smoking/vaping on pool grounds.
- Firearms or other weapons are not permitted on pool grounds.
- Children age 12 and older, at the discretion of the parent/guardian and staff, may use the pool unaccompanied by an adult. Children age 11 and younger must be accompanied by a responsible adult at all times.
- All guests must be accompanied by a member. Members are responsible for their guests at all times. Guests must arrive, sit with and leave with the member.
- Guest fees are charged to all guests over the age of 2.
- Members are encouraged to keep the pool clean by disposing of any trash: this includes the pavilion, rest rooms, pool grounds and snack bar area.
- At the discretion of the pool staff, members and guests who engage in behavior that is deemed to be offensive, dangerous or disruptive may be asked to leave the pool. Repeat behavior will be subject to permanent removal of pool privileges with no refund given.
- Our normal hours of operation are 12:00 pm to 8:00 pm. Special hours may be posted due to holidays, home swim meets, lack of attendance, school calendars or inclement weather.

We appreciate your cooperation with the pool rules. Our goal is to make the pool as safe and well maintained as possible. If you see a situation that is unsafe, or have any questions, see a lifeguard, the pool manager, or a member of the pool board.
