Reading of Minutes

Director's Report: Mr. Doyle

- Band Expo has been postponed due to weather. It is rescheduled for October 25 at 7:00pm.
- In the coming week:
 - Wednesday, Thursday and Friday rehearsal will be as scheduled. However, due to uncertain weather, it could be outside, inside or a combination.
 - Football game is Friday at the new Crowley facility.
 - Saturday is a competition at Burleson. Band hall doors will be open at 7:00am for students to arrive with a departure time of 8:00am. The equipment trailer will be loaded from the football game the night before. Rather than have the students stay at Burleson high school between our preliminary performance and finals performance, it would be beneficial to have them bussed back to CTHS. They would change out of their uniform at Chisholm and have approximately 2 3 hours to rest. There will be a designated space for girls, boys and a quiet room for homework/etc. This would require some parents to stay at Burleson HS with the equipment and trailer. Dinner would be at Burleson HS around 5, right after Prelim awards.
- We are hosting UIL on Tuesday (October 10th). We have lots of things that need to be done. For example: set up tables, post signs. Parents can come to the school during Monday night rehearsal to help set up the night before. We will perform first. Our warm-up will be at 9:00am and our performance at 10:00am. Other bands will arrive beginning around 8:15 8:30. Volunteers will need to be in place by 8:00am. The Keller bands will not be here this year due to a fall break which will make our jobs a little easier.
 - Per Julie volunteers should arrive at 7:30 am (same time as the kids).

- The following week there is another away football game on Friday (13th) with the Birdville competition the next day (14th). The next Friday football game is Homecoming (20th). The band will perform our show after the football game. Area contest is the next day (21st). We will likely be performing in the afternoon (maybe 2:30ish).
- All 17 cactus props are constructed. The frames for the back drops are complete and the vinyl coverings are here. Thank you to everyone who worked on these! Members in attendance were able to see the 2 sided backdrop!
- Questions: Will we have concessions at UIL. Yes, but limited to drinks, chips, candy only. No hot food will be served. One adult and two students will be needed and they are set.
