Director's Report: Ms. Rivers

- The Ranger Regiment is ending a successful marching season. The band made area finals which hasn't been done since 2019.
- The band performed a western themed spirit show at the game against Saginaw last Friday night. We couldn't perform the entire show because the woodwinds were unable to play because of the weather. We will be performing the same show this Friday at the Rangers first ever playoff game. Game tickets will go on sale tomorrow at 1:00 pm.
- CTHS Theater did a show entitled Clue and volunteers from our Jazz band performed in that
- The band has begun preparing holiday music. The concert is December 12th.
- The jazz band concert is on December 10th.
- On December 3rd we are hosting the Brass All Region audition at our school. We need parents to volunteer to be room monitors. We will need a minimum of 20 volunteers. It will start around 6pm. The woodwind auditions are on Dec 5th at Keller Central. There will be a bus providing transportation.
- Winter Guard and Indoor Drumline are starting rehearsals for their competition seasons.
- The Saginaw Holiday parade will be December 7th at 4. The Chisholm Trail Wind Ensemble will march in the parade along with the top bands from Boswell, Saginaw and Eagle Mountain high schools. CTHS drumline will also march in the parade (the percussion section rotates each year). The route has changed, it will begin at Willow Creek and end at the Saginaw Recreation Center.

New Business

- As we end the marching season, please reflect on things that worked well and things that can be improved beginning with registration last spring.
 - Feedback:
 - Why don't we sell merchandise online? We have tried that in the past and we were not getting notified when items are ordered. Also, orders have to be placed in batches (most items have a minimum). When people order single items, it takes too long for them to reach a minimum order number and as a result are not delivered in a timely manner.

Could we buy online and ship directly to the buyer? Andrea Felder will check our website archive for the special order store that was used in the past.

- Per Ms. Rivers, we used a different person to write our show music and drill this year. We received the music in May! This is a huge improvement over past years. In some years, the complete show was not delivered until September or even October.
- A big shout out to Freshmen parents who have really jumped in to help!
- Should we have band representatives go to middle school concerts to show parents and students what they have to look forward to?
- During registration: Many parents liked having kids and parents at the various stations. Many more volunteers are needed for uniform try-ons.
- Should we have a social for parents on parent night?
- Section leaders need to communicate to their section (using their group chat) about our band app. The information must get to the parents.
- The Band Banquet will be May 2 or 3, 2025. We pay approx \$2100 for National Hall which includes linens and kitchen use. (Fri \$1700, Sat \$2100) Set up around 3 or 3:30 and we're done at midnight.
 - O In the past, we have used a band parent to DJ this event. His fee is \$375 (that is discounted for the band). A different band family has offered to DJ the event for a fee of \$40. This would include a photo booth as well which will save money as well. After floor discussion, the decision to hire the new DJ is made. Julie will contact the previous DJ and let him know, due to significant cost savings, we will use a different DJ this year.
 - Since we will not incur the expense of a photo booth (the new DJ provides this) and we are saving money on the DJ, we may use these extra funds to have a boba or candy bar.

- Bring suggestions for food to the next booster meeting. FYI Corey does brisket for \$10 -\$12 (approximately) per meal.
- Bring suggestions for a venue to the booster meeting next month. If better options are not presented, we will vote to hold the banquet at National Hall.
