History: *any four - American History, Art/Music History, Bible History, World History and Geography, *Government/Economics

Electives: *any four credits (most electives are 0.5 credits) - *Communications/ Relationships, *keyboarding or computer science, any Kingdom courses or Creative courses offered, PE
This could include Dual Enrollment Tech courses taken at NACC This could include any independent courses agreed upon by parent and principal.

## Creative Arts Diploma - prepared and ready to follow creative dreams

Math: *three - General Math, *Pre-Algebra, *Algebra I, Consumer Math, Finance, Geometry, Algebra II

English: *a combination of any four - grammar, *creative writing, formal writing, *literature, research and composition

Science: *three - General Science, *Physical science, *Biology, Health and Nutrition, Chemistry

History: *Art History, *Music History, *Government/ Economics, *World History/ Geography, (could include a "history" of a specialized area in place of an art or music history)

Creative Arts courses: *at least 4 credits (some may be worth 0.5 ) These may be diverse in nature or concentrated in a specific area - *Music Theory 101 Advanced Music Theory, Dance, *Drama, Art Application, Choir, Fabric Arts, Computer Science, any other Creative course offered

Electives: *at least two credits (some may be worth 0.5) *Communications/ Relationships, any Kingdom courses or Creative courses offered, any other general education electives offered

## *Required for Diploma

Any Creative Arts skills being developed outside of school hours will be credited as well. ( 120 hours $=1$ credit, 60 hours $=0.5$ credit) Examples include, but are not limited to: dance classes, individual instrument or voice lessons

History: *four -*American History I, *American History II, *Government/Economics, *World History/Geography

Electives: *at least six credits (most electives are 0.5 credits) -
*Communications/Relationships, *Speech, *Finance, *PE or dance,
*Health and Nutrition, *The Truth Project, *Music Theory, *drama, *Art or Music History, any Kingdom courses or Creative courses offered This could include Dual Enrollment courses taken at NACC
This could include any independent courses agreed upon by parent and principal.

All students will receive 1 Bible credit per year during the HS years.

## ACT required to graduate

High School Mentoring Expectations for graduation:

- Complete a love language, personality, and spiritual gifts assessment
- Follow-up reading on the importance of the assessments
- Required reading: at least 2 assigned books per year with follow-up discussion, paper, or project; up to the discretion of the mentor
- at least 10 hours of community service per HS year
- meet with mentor once a month for check in, prayer, encouragement
- one in-country mission trip
- one out of country mission trip encouraged
- leadership training
