

1. Name

The name of the corporation is: Mujaay Ganma Foundation Aboriginal Corporation.

2. Objectives

The overarching objective of the organisation is to improve the wellbeing of Country and community with respect for culture.

The corporation aims to:

- Support the passing on of cultural knowledge from Elders to the younger generations
- Improve the wellbeing of Country through providing learning on the job opportunities for young custodians to learn from Elders and knowledge holders, how to care for Country in culturally respectful ways
- Engage in seed collecting, propagation and growing native plants endemic to Country
- Regenerate Country to improve native habitat
- Provide cultural support for people affected by cancer.
- Educate people in communities about the issues facing people with cancer.
- Partner with other organisations with similar aims in the wider community to better meet the cultural needs of Aboriginal people and the wellbeing of the whole community.
- Help create healthy communities through supporting healthy lifestyles. Supporting physical, mental, emotional and spiritual wellbeing with respect for cultural values and ways of being.

To operate and maintain a gift fund to be known as ‘The Mujaay Ganma Foundation Aboriginal Corporation Gift Fund’ in accordance with the requirements of the Income Tax Assessment Act 1997.
