Just a couple of reminders:

The fire hydrants will be flushed out at the beginning of October.

At this time the leaf pick-up window is up to the leaves. It usually begins sometime in October and goes for 3-4 weeks. Please tell the person clearing your yard that in order for the leaf vacuum to pick up, the piles need to be at the edge of your yard by the street and there can't be any sticks in your leaf piles.

If you haven't already noticed, the recycling schedule has changed to every other Monday. You can always view the pick-up schedule on our website https://Michianavillage.org

If you leave for long periods of time here are a few things to remember:

- *Pull your garbage cans back from the edge of the road so the garbage service knows there is nothing to empty. It also helps keep the Village looking uncluttered.
- *You can have your water turned off at the street by calling the Village office. This helps prevent being charged for any leaks that may happen while you are away. There is a \$25 turn off fee and a \$25 turn on fee.
- *We aren't there yet, but remember to change the batteries in thermostats if you are leaving for a long period of time. If your heat goes out it could lead to frozen water pipes.
