Approximately 50 loads of leaves were taken out of the village. Unfortunately a winter snow storm hit us early this year and combined with our trees not really losing leaves until early November we had approximately three weeks to pick up leaves. We never even got beyond the Old Grand Beach area. Now we have a situation where leaves can not be picked up due to the wet, snow, and cold. There will be a Spring leaf pick-up. Dates will be announced.



If you are leaving for a long period of time:

\*\*Pull your garbage cans back from the edge of the road so the garbage service knows there is nothing to empty. It also helps keep the Village looking uncluttered.

\*\*Please remember to change the batteries in thermostats. If your heat goes out it could lead to frozen water pipes.

\*\*You can also have your water turned off at the street by calling the Village office. Turning the water off in the house will not help if a pipe were to freeze and break in your yard. Turning the water off at the street is a preventative measure against breaking pipes. There is a \$25 turn off fee and a \$25 turn on fee for this service.
