## Michiana Village Master Plan Survey #1

What improvements would you like to see in the Village?

Question 11 of the survey asked,

"What improvements would you like to see in the Village?"

The question was answered by **216 respondents**:

- There were **713 individual suggestions** for "improvement"
- There were 22 responses that were unclear or neutral



- Responses containing several ideas were separated into individual suggestions
- The individual suggestions were edited to clarify their meaning
  - If the reviewer was unsure of his interpretation the suggestion was reviewed by ChatGPT4.0 for meaning
- A list of 101 gross categories were created and each of the suggestions was assigned to up to three
  - See Table 1
- The gross categories were then assigned to 43 sub-categories under six main categories
  - See Table 2

### All Suggestions by General Categories (713 responses)

# Beaches received the most suggestions for improvement followed by Infrastructure & Public Works, Policy & Zoning, and Parks & Recreation.

Over 60% of all responses about <u>beaches</u> were suggestions to maintain and improve beach access. Another 23% were concerns about beach hazards and erosion.

#### Key community comments on maintaining and/or improving beaches, stops, and stairs

- "Improve beach maintenance—bring back regular raking and debris removal like in past years."
- "Repair and upgrade beach access points, especially Stop 43, which floods and needs better stairs and drainage."
- "Ensure wider, safer, and more accessible stairs and pathways to the beach for all users, including those with disabilities."
- "Provide porta-potties and water stations (like showers or fountains) at more beach stops, especially new or popular ones."
- "Expand and improve kayak/SUP storage near beach access, with options for multiple spaces per household."
- "Don't charge residents for beach access or kayak use—we already pay taxes!"
- "Place more garbage cans at beach stops and keep them year-round to manage pet and visitor waste."
- "Add storage options for beach chairs and other gear directly on or near the beach."
- "Open all beach stops and continue year-round investment in beach access infrastructure."
- "Care for and invest in beaches as a community asset, ensuring they are clean, safe, and welcoming."



28% of all responses about <u>infrastructure & public works</u> suggested improvements in road maintenance followed by better electricity reliability, telecommunication systems, and public property clean-up.

#### Key community comments on improving road maintenance and reliability of utility services

- "Fix potholes and repave roads consistently, with special attention to high-use areas like Michiana Drive, Chicagami, and Lake Shore Drive."
- "Establish a long-term road maintenance plan that includes drainage improvements, ice treatment, and timely repairs—not just random cold patching."
- "Improve electrical grid reliability and reduce power outages, especially in vulnerable areas like southeast Village near Grand Beach Rd."
- "Bury power and communication lines to prevent outages, protect views, and enhance the appearance of Lake Shore Drive."
- "Upgrade street infrastructure—including stormwater management—to reduce flooding, standing water, and winter hazards."
- "Enhance cell service throughout the Village, including the beach and lakeshore areas, with options like new towers or boosters."
- "Improve Wi-Fi and internet access across the community, including 5G availability and service at the beach."
- "End the internet monopoly—bring in additional providers to improve service and affordability."
- "Maintain overhead utility lines and poles until they can be moved underground; repair damaged infrastructure proactively."
- "Boost communication and transparency about roadwork, utility maintenance, and service restoration timelines."



### Almost 30% of all responses about <u>Village policies & zoning</u> were related to short-term rentals.

#### Key community comments relating to short-term rentals, night-time lighting, and building, planning, zoning ordinances

- "Limit short-term rentals and enforce rules on noise, garbage, parking, and overcrowding to preserve the village's peaceful character."
- "Adopt and enforce a minimum rental duration (e.g., one month) to discourage constant turnover and restore neighborhood stability."
- "Strengthen enforcement of existing rental ordinances and increase accountability for non-compliant owners and repeat offenders."
- "Adopt a 'Dark Sky' policy—limit unnecessary outdoor lighting, spotlighting, and house floods to reduce light pollution and enjoy night skies."
- "Require all exterior lighting to face downward or use motion sensors to eliminate glare and preserve village ambiance."
- "Enforce and revise zoning rules to prevent oversized homes on small lots and ensure consistent application of building codes."
- "Encourage larger lots and thoughtful spacing in new development to avoid crowding and maintain open character."
- "Discourage commercialization of homes solely for rental use and restrict new modular or large-scale speculative builds."
- "Enhance code enforcement for visible disrepair, excessive signage, and storage that affects neighborhood aesthetics."
- "Refocus Village efforts on core community values—peace, quiet, and natural beauty over amenities like sports courts or beautification projects."



### Over half of all responses about <u>parks & recreation</u> were suggestions to create more community events and to add amenities at the community hall

#### Key community comments on creating more community events and adding amenities to the community hall

"Improve access to public bathrooms year-round—especially at parks, Village Hall, and the community center—and avoid using portable toilets."

<sup>&</sup>quot;Host more community events like concerts, movie nights, food truck evenings, happy hours, and mixers to foster connection among residents."

<sup>&</sup>quot;Expand recreational programming at the community center—offer yoga, fitness, gardening, music, art, and classes for all ages."

<sup>&</sup>quot;Make Village Hall a year-round community hub with open hours, card nights, coffee socials, book clubs, and better accessibility."

<sup>&</sup>quot;Support more outdoor events in the park—live music, fitness classes, movie nights, and a seasonal pavilion or stage."

<sup>&</sup>quot;Introduce a regular farmers market or pop-up shops and consider small-scale local businesses like a café, ice cream stand, or convenience store."

<sup>&</sup>quot;Encourage recycling and sustainability—restore the recycling center, offer annual electronics collection, and explore composting services."

<sup>&</sup>quot;Create more opportunities for teens and young adults—programs like sports tournaments, movie nights, and board game events."

<sup>&</sup>quot;Improve facilities and equipment—upgrade Village Hall floors, bathrooms, sound systems, and explore installing a car charging station."

<sup>&</sup>quot;Preserve and enhance the village's natural beauty with garden walks, outdoor seating, bigger windows in public buildings.."



### 80% of all responses about <u>enforcement & safety</u> were related unsafe driving & road hazards, noise, and police patrols.

#### Key community comments regarding road safety, noise, and public safety

"Increase police presence and enforcement—especially in summer months—to address speeding, noise, fireworks, and ordinance violations."

<sup>&</sup>quot;Implement stricter regulations on golf carts: age limits, safety belts, speed control, enforcement of stop signs, and possible special licensing."

<sup>&</sup>quot;Strictly enforce fireworks restrictions—ban military-grade displays, prohibit use near homes, and issue permits only to residents."

<sup>&</sup>quot;Lower and clearly mark speed limits, especially near parks and hills; install more speed bumps where necessary."

<sup>&</sup>quot;Improve signage for speed, stop signs, pedestrians, and safety zones—ensure visibility and proper placement to reduce confusion and risk."

<sup>&</sup>quot;Support continued funding for a dedicated Village Police Department to maintain responsive, local public safety oversight."

<sup>&</sup>quot;Improve regulation of noise, including pickleball hours, leaf blowers, and overall quiet hours, to preserve the Village's peaceful environment."

<sup>&</sup>quot;Ensure safe use of public roads—ticket cars parked dangerously, enforce no-parking zones like on the lake side of LSD, and prohibit overnight street parking on well-traveled roads."

<sup>&</sup>quot;Address pedestrian safety by widening roads like Lake Shore Drive and educating walkers, joggers, and cyclists on safe road sharing."

<sup>&</sup>quot;Maintain and clear public rights-of-way—trim overgrown areas to improve visibility and safety at intersections and paths."




Almost 80% of all responses about <u>Village management</u> were related to taxes & spending, improvements in communications from the Village, and general concerns about Village politics


#### Key community comments on Village taxes and spending, communications and politics

- "Publish the full budget and clearly report how all funds, including dispensary taxes, are spent."
- "Improve communication—share updates in advance via newsletter, website, and community groups."
- "Give summer taxpayers more say in decisions, committees, and votes."
- "Be fiscally responsible—avoid unnecessary projects and keep taxes under control."
- "Lower or waive resident fees for hall rental, trash, water, and Airbnb licenses."
- "Ensure council listens to all residents, not just a few."
- "Create and promote an online resident directory with new resident updates."
- "Allow anonymous ordinance reports to protect neighbor relations."
- "Share a village-recommended list of local services and tradespeople."
- "Assign council members to oversee key areas like the park for better accountability."
