The Village of Michiana is in a designated protected area known also as a Critical Dune Area (CDA). The Village Council has approved the following list of trees that are native to the State of Michigan and based on recommendations by the Michigan Department of Natural Resources (MDNR). To support the delicate ecosystem of the coastal dunes and fortify the resources against lake erosion and to be good stewards to the CDA where residents have chosen to live, it is requested that homeowners consider planting the following tree species.

The following genus of trees are DESIRABLE species:

White Oaks (*Quercus alba*)
Red Maple (*Acer rubrum*)
Sugar Maple (*Acer saccharum*)
American Linden/Basswood (*Tilia americana*)
Black Gum or Tupelo (*Nyssa sylvatica*)
Flowering Dogwood (*Cornus florida*)
Hickory (*Carya spp*)
Hop-Hornbeam or Ironwood (*Ostrya virginiana*)
Hornbeam or Blue Beech (*Carpinus caroliniana*)
Smooth Shadbush (*Amelanchier leavis*)
Kentucky Coffeetree (*Gymnocladus dioica*)
Juneberry (*Amelanchier leavis* & *A. canadensis*)
Eastern Red Cedar (*Juniperus virginiana*)
Eastern White Pine (*Pinus strobus*)
Balsam Fir (*Abies balsamea*)
Hemlock (*Tsuga canadensis*)
White cedar Arborvitae (*Thuja occidentalis*)

The following trees are UNDESIRABLE tree species:

Black Alder (*Alnus glutinosa*)
Black Cherry (*Prunus serotina*)
Black Locust (*Robinia pseudoacacia*)
Box Elder (*Acer negundo*)
Catalpa (*Catalpa speciosa*)
European White Birch (*Betula pendula*)
Ginko (*Ginkgo biloba* male and female)
Common Honeylocust (*Gleditsia tinctoria*) thorned variety
Japanese Maple (*Acer saccharinum*)
Norway Maple (*Acer platanoides*)
Russian Olive (*Elaeagnus angustifolia*)
Silver Maple (*Acer saccharinum*)
Tree of Heaven (*Ailanthus altissima*)
White Mulberry (*Morus alba*)
Red Mulberry (*Morus rubra*)
Poplars (*Populus species*)
Willows (*Salix species*)
Siberian Elm (*Ulmus pumila*)
Russian Olive (*Elaeagnus angustifolia*)
