

**Village of Michiana  
Workshop Meeting Minutes  
October 10, 2025**

The Workshop Meeting of the Village of Michiana was called to order at 11:00 a.m. at the Village Hall.

**Purpose:**

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss ideas related to short-term rentals within the Village.

**Roll Call:**

President Tim McCarthy, Brian Cassidy, Mike Mumper, Nancy Thill. Also Present: Police Chief Ryan Layman, Street and Water Superintendent Rick Reitz, Tracey McCay/Treasurer and Attorney Sarah Senica. Tim McCarthy excused Mike Botelho and Anne Heywood/Clerk.

**Attendance:**

There were approximately 35 residents present in person and 13 attending online.

**Discussion:**

Tim McCarthy facilitated the meeting and invited residents to share their comments. Each resident was given three minutes to speak, and a timer was set to ensure equal time for all. Residents introduced themselves and shared their ideas and opinions regarding short-term rentals.

After public comments, Tim read 30 letters that had been submitted by residents who could not attend in person.

Topics discussed included:

- Possible revisions to existing short-term rental forms
- Garbage service arrangements
- Limits or percentages on the number of short-term rentals permitted
- General suggestions to improve enforcement and clarity of the ordinance

Tim noted that many of the ideas mentioned by residents are already reflected in the current short-term rental ordinance.

**Next Steps:**

The Council will review the existing ordinance and consider whether any updates or adjustments are necessary based on the feedback received.

The meeting was adjourned at 12:40 p.m. by Tim McCarthy.
