Golf Carts: Please remember that only LICENSED DRIVERS are permitted to operate motorized vehicles on the road, including golf carts.

Parking: When parking near the beach and park or near your homes please keep all tires completely off the road.

Dogs in Park: Please remember there are no dogs allowed in the park.

Contractors: A reminder that all contractors working in the Village need to register with the Village office.

Fireworks Ordinance 2017-03

Ordinance to provide for the regulation of the ignition, discharge, and use of consumer fireworks in the Village of Michiana.

The following dates and times are the only dates and times that the Village can not restrict:

- *11:00am on December 31st—1:00am on January 1st
- *11:00am—11:45pm on Saturday and Sunday immediately preceding Memorial Day
- *11:00am—11:45pm on June 29th—July 4th
- *11:00am—11:45pm on the Saturday and Sunday immediately preceding Labor Day

Construction Ordinance 2016-03

An ordinance to restrict the hours of construction, alteration, demolition, and repair activities conducted in the Village of Michiana for the good of the public health, safety, and peace of Village residents is:

- *restricted on Sundays and Holidays
- *only allowed during the hours of 8:00am—5:00pm EST from Monday—Friday
- *Saturday construction may be done during the hours of 10:00am—5:00pm EST
