Hello Michiana,

On behalf of the Village Council and our Planning Commission, I am excited to share the news that the Village of Michiana is developing a new Master Plan. Community engagement is key to designing our future plans that represent what the community is, what its residents value, and what they hope the community will become.

Over the next year, we will request your input in two surveys, and participation in a community workshop.

In January, we will ask for your help in answering the first survey. All residents will receive a QR code with directions for completing the survey via mail with your water bill. If you are setup for ACH payments for your water bill, you will only receive the survey notification.

Our master plan will establish a direction for future growth, land use, infrastructure, public, residential, and recreation service priorities with a five year or longer timeframe.

Please complete this first survey by February 7. We look forward to working with you on our future Master Plan and appreciate your help in kicking off the process.

One hundred and seventeen loads of leaves were taken out of the Village this season. There will be a leaf pick-up in the Spring. These dates are to be announced.

*Reminder: The garbage service will take **Christmas trees**. You just need to put them out next to your garbage bins on pick-up day.

*Please remember to change the batteries in thermostats if you are leaving for a long period of time. If your heat goes out it could lead to frozen water pipes.

*Pull your garbage cans back from the edge of the road so the garbage service knows there is nothing to empty. It also helps keep the Village looking uncluttered.

*You can have your water turned off at the street by calling the Village office. This helps prevent you being charged for any leaks that may happen while you are away. There is a \$25 turn off fee and a \$25 turn on fee for this service.
