Village News:

The Village Hall now has new lighting, new electrical, new celling fans, new outlets for uplighting in the attic, clean windows and doors, painted outside stairs, and a staged seating area. The Village is in the process of getting quotes for painting the venting and towers so they blend better with the rest of the hall. We are also looking into cleaning the celling. With all the new, beautiful up lighting the rafters are looking a bit dusty. The painting and cleaning should be done before Thanksgiving.

We have installed new exterior cameras around the Village Hall.

The park is also getting a make-over. The uneven mix of weeds and crab grass is being replaced with a nice smooth lawn along

- *Coming soon will be a letter from the Village office. Included in that letter is an Emergency Contact Form. It is important for the police to have this contact information in their possession just in case any emergency should happen at your residence.

Friendly Reminders:

The police have a drug disposal box if you need to dispose of old medications. You can either bring them to the police or drop them off at the Village office for disposal.

Please have all watercraft off the kayak racks by October 15th. By this date, anything left on the beach will be collected and there will be a citation issued.

The Village will begin leaf pickup toward the end of October and will continue through December 1st. These dates are approximate depending on the leaves falling.

If you haven't already noticed, the recycling schedule has changed to every other Monday. When the Summer season begins after Memorial Day, the recycling schedule will switch back to every Monday. You can always view the schedule on our website https://Michianavillage.org

If you leave for long periods of time here are a few things to remember:

- *Pull your garbage cans back from the edge of the road so the garbage service knows there is nothing to empty. It also helps keep the Village looking uncluttered.
- *You can have your water turned off at the street by calling the Village office. This helps prevent you being charged for any leaks that may happen while you are away. There is a \$25 turn off fee and a \$25 turn on fee.
- *We aren't there yet, but remember to change the batteries in thermostats if you are leaving for a long period of time. If your heat goes out it could lead to frozen water pipes.
