We have found what we consider a reasonable compromise given the cart situation and the trepidation that some members feel about being assigned to random pairings. We understand that personal choice is important for members to feel safe. We cannot control what the golf course mandates and whether they put in partitions, but....

If you are so inclined, you may pick one permanent partner to share a cart with this year.

If you do not want to pick a permanent partner then you will be assigned a random pairing each week.

No foursomes will be permanently assigned. This is so all the members still get to play with each other.

If you choose to play with a permanent partner this year, then both members will play on any given week, or both members will sit out. There will be no individuals in carts this year. If your partner cannot play on any given day and you still want to play, then you will be assigned a random partner for that week.

Because we are allowing pairings, it will no longer be possible to play team events as we will not be able to create flights for all team events. New games will replace the ones that will no longer work.
