HOW TO IMPROVE PACE OF PLAY

Arrive at the tee with your golf equipment in order, ready to play. Remember essentials like extra balls, tees, gloves & ball markers.

Aim to play in 20 seconds

From club selection to pre-shot routine to execution, strive to hit your shot in 20 seconds when it is your turn to play.

Plan your shot before you get to your ball

Once you are off the tee, think ahead. Make your club selection before it is your turn to play. Very often, you can do this while others are playing, without disruption.

Keep your pre-shot routine short

Try to take no more than one practice swing, then set up to the ball and play your shot. **Most importantly, be ready to hit when it is your turn.**

Be helpful to others in your group

Follow the flight of all tee shots, not just your own. Once in the fairway, play your ball if near and then help others look for their lost ball. Volunteer to fill in a divot or rake a bunker for another player if needed.

Be efficient on the putting green

Mark your ball and lift and clean it when you arrive at the putting green so you will be ready to replace it when it is your turn to play. You can usually line up your putt while others are putting, without disturbing them. Leave your clubs on the side of the putting green closest to the next tee, and leave the green promptly after holing out. **Wait until the next tee to record your score**.

BACKUP SCORECARD— Record gross scores to verify with the official scorecard. Keep track of Game of the day scores on backup scorecard. DO NOT turn this card into Proshop

GOLF GENIUS— **One Player** of the foursome will record team scores for each hole. **GGID** is located on the bottom right of scorecard.

Golf Genius and Official Scorecard must match hole by hole or you may be disqualified!
