ORDER: CONTINUING COURT PROCEEDINGS

Pursuant to the Supreme Court of the State of Oklahoma and The Oklahoma Court of Criminal Appeals SCAD NO. 2020-24 attached hereto, effective March 17, 2020, the Courts in Payne and Logan Counties shall be open for business as follows:

1. All jury trials, non-jury trials and preliminary hearings for Payne and Logan Counties are hereby stricken for the months of March and April. Jury trial dates shall be rescheduled for May and June on the Courts May dockets.
2. All Civil Division dockets will be continued to the May dockets of each Judge, with the exception of statutory time limits for hearing.
3. All in custody Felony and Misdemeanor dockets shall continue to operate as scheduled. All out of custody cases shall be continued to the May docket. All Arraignments shall remain as scheduled.
4. All Domestic dockets shall be continued to the May dockets. Temporary hearings and Emergency Protective Order dockets shall remain as scheduled.
5. All Deprived dockets shall be continued to the May dockets except DHS emergency matters relating to child protection or custody.
6. All Juvenile Delinquent dockets shall remain as scheduled.
7. All emergency guardianship matters shall remain as scheduled.

This Order is subject to modification.
