Tips for your Ad copy:

Keep your copy simple. Too much copy in an ad will lose your reader.

Proofing your ad is encouraged, leave an email address and it can be sent prior to printing.

Some editing, abbreviating, etc., may be done to copy prior to design completion.

Avoiding all capitals and all italicized text is important for easy reading.

Try to not do black backgrounds and reverse print. If you must do that, stick with a block type.

Once the pages are sent to press, we cannot guarantee the print. We make it the best we can and then hand our trust into the printer's hands.

I-O SUBMISSION STANDARDS

We gladly accept digital submissions of photographs. To insure the highest quality reproduction we request the following standards.

Resolution must be at least a 300 dpi at reproduction size. Sending our files to press require 200 dpi.

2. We prefer to work from the original camera file or scan. Your modifications to the file may look good on your screen or printer, however, for reproduction in a newspaper settings are different.

If you wish to bring a print in that originated on a digital camera, make sure it is as big as possible. We prefer to have the unedited camera file as each generation adds to the degradation of image quality. If you have printed a digital file and we need to scan it, reproduction will never look as high quality as e-mailing or bringing in the file.

We cannot make a poor aimage good. If there is any question as to the reproducibility of an image please feel free to bring the original in to the Independent-Observer.

In some cases, depending on workflow, we are able to scan your original and return it directly to you.

In all cases original photographs remain the property of the owner unless otherwise agreed upon before reproduction.

Photos that have been left for reproduction can be picked up at our office after publication.

Photo credit will be given where deemed appropriate by the I-O staff.

Acceptable file types for digital submission: PDF files ● JPEG ● Tiff ● PNG

Word document is preferred for copy, or typed in the body of an email.

We are not able to work with Publisher documents.

Pictures need to be submitted as a separate entity.
