

All sales are final. Lovie Rose Farm strives to maintain a healthy herd and test annually for Johnes and CAE with a NEGATIVE test results this year of **May 5,2021** We also make sure all animals are healthy before leaving for their new homes. Once an animal leaves our farm we are no longer responsible for that animal. A health certificate can be acquired through our local veterinarian at the request and cost to the Buyer.

All kids will be disbudded, vaccinated, and tattooed before leaving the farm, unless otherwise stated. I also microchip most the registrable animals, I do not microchip castrated males.

If you do not already own goats I suggest reading articles on how to raise dairy goats and will provide some websites in a folder when you pick up your goat. If you do not already own goats we will not sell a single goat and require that you buy at least two. Goats are herd animals and do not generally do well alone. Wethers (neutered/castrated boys) make great companion animals for both does and bucks as they are inexpensive and low maintenance.

REGISTRATION

Registrable goats will either be registered before leaving or come with an application to be registered with ADGA.

DEPOSITS

A non-refundable 50% deposit will hold the animal for up to 2 weeks while pick up arrangements are being made. The balance remainder can be paid in cash or PayPal at time of pick up. If using a transport, the animal must be paid for in full before it can leave our farm. It is the buyer's responsibility to stay in touch with us. If we do not hear from you after your 2 week deposit period is over, we reserve the right to offer said animal for sale again. If a deposit has been put on an animal and the buyer backs out, there is no refund of monies paid in.

If for any reason, after the deposit is made, the goat becomes sick or injured the deposit will be refunded.

We reserve the right to refuse any sale at anytime for any reason with deposit refunded.

PAYMENTS

We accept cash and PayPal for deposits and final payment at pickup

SHIPPING/PICKUP/DELIVERY

All animals must be picked up at our farm unless prior arrangements have been made. Please do NOT bring other animals with you to pick up.

We will gladly deliver your kids to any show that we are attending, free of charge.

If you or a designated ground shipper plan to pick up your goat at the farm please make sure to bring a crate or trailer that is the correct size for the animal's comfort. We recommend at least a 24" dog crate to accommodate an adult Nigerian Dwarf or up to 2 kids. Two adults will fit in the 36" crate. Lining the crate with wood shavings or straw will keep the animals dry & comfortable for their trip home.
