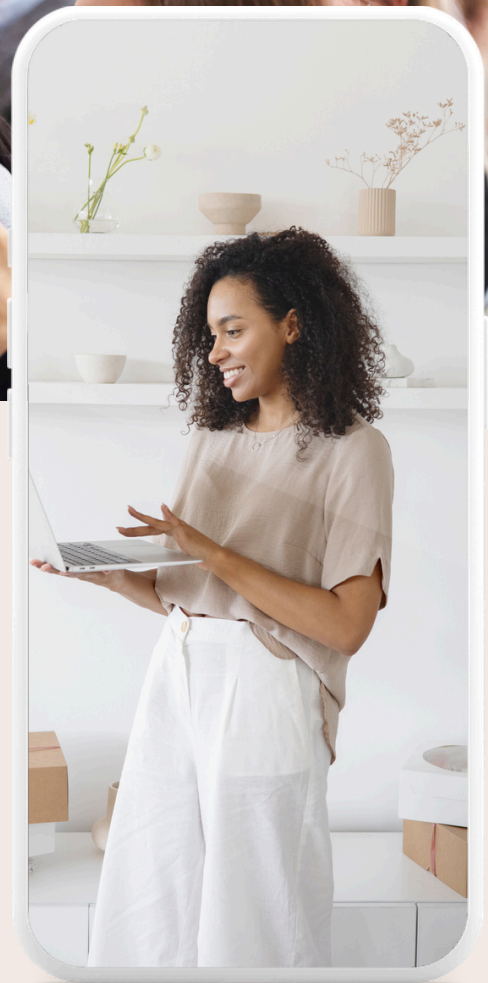
Ambassadors play an important role in helping us extend our reach, shape our future direction, and maintain a supportive, engaged community.

THE AMBASSADOR ROLE – OVERVIEW



The Ladies of Law Ambassador role is a voluntary, unpaid position. Ambassadors act as advocates for the community, helping to amplify our message, contribute ideas, and support future growth.

In return, ambassadors gain:

- Recognition as a Ladies of Law Ambassador
- Inclusion within the Ladies of Law ambassador and wider community
- Opportunities to contribute to events, content, and initiatives
- The ability to list the role on CVs and social media profiles
- Access to connections, collaboration opportunities, and community benefits associated with Ladies of Law



WHAT WE ASK OF OUR AMBASSADORS

1. Supporting Community Growth and Engagement

Ambassadors are asked to actively support the growth and engagement of the Ladies of Law community by:

- Liking, sharing, and commenting on Ladies of Law social media posts
- Helping to increase visibility of our content across LinkedIn, Instagram, TikTok, and other relevant platforms
- Positively engaging with community discussions and content where appropriate

This support helps extend our reach organically and strengthens the sense of an active, engaged community.

2. Helping to Grow and Develop the Brand

Ambassadors play a key role in strengthening the Ladies of Law brand by:

- Recommending Ladies of Law to their own professional networks and communities
- Suggesting potential new ambassadors who align with our values and mission
- Introducing or recommending potential supportive partners, sponsors, or collaborators
 - For example, organisations or individuals who may offer sponsorship, resources, expertise, or event support

Ambassadors are not expected to sell or formally represent Ladies of Law, but rather to act as trusted advocates within their own circles.

3. Contributing Ideas and Shaping Future Opportunities

We want ambassadors to help shape the future direction of Ladies of Law. This may include:

- Being part of an ambassador WhatsApp group or similar forum
- Sharing ideas and suggestions for future opportunities and development
- Recommending potential guests for the Ladies of Law podcast
- Suggesting speakers, topics, or collaborators for virtual or in-person events
- Highlighting emerging issues, trends, or opportunities within the legal profession
- Contributing any other ideas that could add value to the community

We are particularly keen to hear ambassadors' perspectives on what women in law genuinely need and value.





Time Commitment

The ambassador role is designed to be flexible and manageable alongside full-time work or other commitments. There is no fixed minimum time requirement, but ambassadors should feel able to:

- Engage regularly with Ladies of Law content
- Participate occasionally in ambassador discussions
- Contribute ideas and support when opportunities arise

Who We Are Looking For

We are looking for individuals who:

- Are supportive of women in law and aligned with the Ladies of Law mission
- Are active on social media or within professional communities
- Enjoy sharing ideas, making connections, and contributing to community growth
- Are collaborative, positive, and willing to support others

Ambassadors do not need to be senior or highly visible figures. Passion, alignment, and willingness to contribute are more important than job title or years of experience.





Interview/Conversation Prompts

6. Are there any individuals or organisations you feel could add value as ambassadors or partners?
7. What would you hope to gain personally or professionally from being an ambassador?

- Agree how the ambassador role will be presented publicly
- Share next steps for onboarding into the ambassador community
