EGD Procedure Information

You are scheduled for an **EGD** with Dr. Kellen Jex.

Required bloodwork should not be drawn any sooner than **ONE MONTH** before your scheduled procedure.

DAY BEFORE PROCEDURE:

Do not eat or drink after midnight UNLESS TOLD OTHERWISE BY DR. JEX.

DAY OF PROCEDURE:

*Take your morning medications, if any, with a sip of water.

*If you use an inhaler, take a treatment the morning of your procedure.

*If you are a **DIABETIC**, please call your primary care provider for dosage changes at least by the day before the procedure.

*** If you take BLOOD THINNERS, it is VERY IMPORTANT to inform Dr. Jex so a plan can be made to either stop or continue these medications leading up to your procedure. BLOOD THINNERS include but are not limited to:**

Coumadin (Warfarin), Eliquis (Apixaban), Xarelto (Rivaroxaban), Plavix (Clopidogrel), Pletal (Cilostazol).

If you take any of the following medications, hold these injections for two weeks prior to your procedure:

- **Ozempic**
- **Semaglutide**
- **Wegovy**
- **Mounjaro**
- **Liraglutide**
- **Tirzepatide**

Other Important Considerations:

- **If you take INSULIN, you need to discuss this with your primary care provider before the day of your procedure.**
- **HOLD NSAIDS for SEVEN days prior to your scheduled procedure. YOU MAY NEED TO HOLD ASPIRIN; HOWEVER, please let our staff know if you have had a HEART ATTACK or STROKE. YOU MAY NEED TO CONTINUE YOUR ASPIRIN FOR YOUR PROCEDURE.**
- **NOTHING to eat or drink after midnight the night before your procedure unless otherwise instructed.**
