

# **Meeting Regarding the NYSEG Proposed New High Voltage Powerline**

**Thursday, May 17th at 7 PM**  
**Cortland County Office Building Auditorium**  
**60 Central Ave, Cortland**

Landowners and elected officials from all affected towns and counties  
are encouraged to attend.

The access door is on the parking lot side of the County Office Building and has a handicapped access ramp. The Auditorium is on the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor. One can either walk up the stairs or take the elevator that can be found down the hallway from the entry door.

The Broome/Cortland/Onondaga Forest, Farm, and Home Preservation Alliance is holding an informational meeting regarding the 345 kV powerline that NYSEG is proposing to build along the existing powerline corridor from Oakdale (by Johnson City) to north of Lafayette.

We will be discussing the following:

1. Updates regarding the proposed powerline and project timing.
2. A discussion of potential risks associated with high voltage transmission lines, in response to several questions at previous meetings.
3. We will be providing an opportunity for landowners who may be affected by this to present their stories, concerns, and expectations. If you would like to share information regarding your situation, but do not wish to speak, we would encourage you to share by email or in writing, and we will gladly read them for you.

We agree that New York's energy system needs to be updated. We support these upgrades as long as they are safe, effective, and necessary, and if affected landowners are treated fairly. The proposed easements do not protect landowners or treat them fairly, and we are asking that the easements as proposed not be signed.

We are also planning meetings in the near future in Lafayette and Lisle. We look forward to seeing you and thank you for your participation.
