Dear Twin Oaks Farm,

I write to provide an update on NYSEG's proposed Oakdale to Layette transmission project which is a part of our Brightline BES Initiative. As an owner of property near the Oakdale to Layette's proposed route, we feel it is important that you receive the latest and most up-to-date information about the project.

The Brightline Bulk Electric System (BES) Initiative is a multi-year NYSEG electric transmission system upgrade program that will assure the company complies with mandatory reliability requirements from the North American Electric Reliability Corporation (NERC).

The project has been proposed to ensure that the regional electric grid meets new national standards for reliability determined by the North American Electric Reliability Corporation (NERC).

During our most recent annual transmission reliability study process, it became clear that the current load forecasts from the New York Independent System Operator (NYISO), which represent a significant reduction from prior forecasts, requires NYSEG to perform a re-assessment of the need for some of the planned BES program transmission projects.

NYSEG plans to finish the re-assessment study by the end of 2018. During this time, we will not be actively engaged in any activities related to the development of the line.

NYSEG is moving forward with the Brightline BES projects that have already been re-confirmed as needed to meet NERC reliability mandates.

NYSEG's core goal is to provide safe and reliable energy for our customers. Our company thrives at being good neighbors and will continue to work collaboratively with landowners, community leaders and regulators throughout this process. Once our re-evaluation is complete, we will determine the best path forward and share our plans with you and the community.
