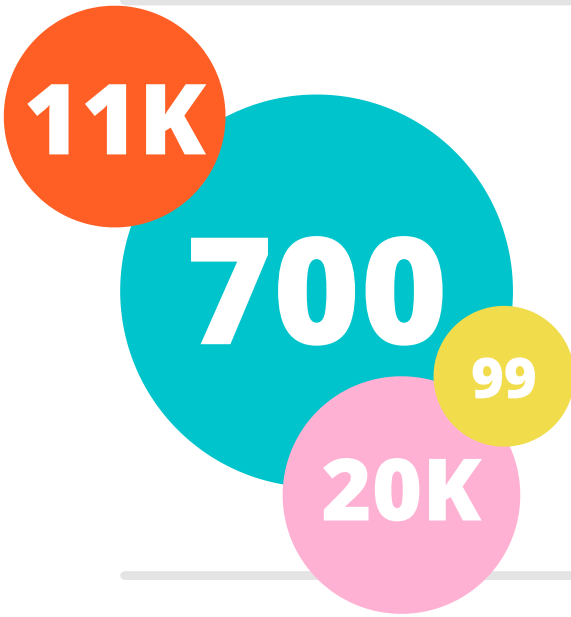
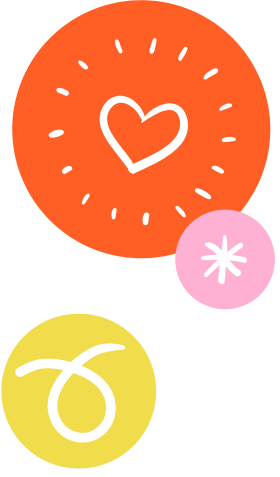


Seattle Special Education PTSA
