OD Greens LLC believes that healthy, civically engaged communities are a powerful force in the fights for fresh, healthy food and against hunger. Because of this, we have designed our products to strengthen the ties between people. Local agriculture offers not only a chance to grow local economies, but it also strengthens the bonds between people within communities. We believe that knowing the person who grows your food and where your food comes from should be an important part of the American lifestyle.

The Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) program is designed to support local, year-round small businesses and to provide nutritious, delicious greens and herbs to the Lake and Geauga county Community with 3-month, 6-month, and 1-year shares. We believe that even small programs can combat big problems in the world and we are very excited to invite you to embark on this adventure. And remember, that by purchasing produce from OD Greens YOU are helping to support training for disabled military veterans!

About this CSA

The OD Greens CSA will provide vertically grown, locally produced greens and herbs year-round, with some specialty items available throughout the year. (A tentative crop list is attached.) Our CSA is in its first year of operation. The CSA is harvested weekly, with share sizes expected to be around 1 – 2 lbs./week. Pickup, payment, and detailed share information is listed later in this document. CSA members accept both, the risks and rewards of farming when joining.

Our Practices

All of our products are grown locally within Willoughby, Ohio city limits using specialized growing techniques. Our farm uses towers in a vertical hydroponic system. All pest control is accomplished using OMRI (organic) certified controls and methods. We invite CSA members to come and learn about our farm and production techniques first hand on a Farm Tour, available for purchase at odgreens.com

Payment Policy

We expect payment due in full when turning in the contract. This arrangement allows us to buy the seeds, transplants, and other inputs we need for the growing season, and pay their farm labor without waiting until harvest to generate revenue. The initial, CSA cycle will start around February 11th and will run year-round. Exact share size and products may vary slightly from week to week due to learning curve, timing, and conditions.

6 mo. (24 Weeks): \$312 (\$13/wk)
1 year (48 weeks): \$528 (\$11/wk) + a free Farm Tour

Crop List for the OD Greens CSA Year-Round Greens and Herbs

Greens

Arugula (Astro)

A selection of regular arugula with less deeply lobed leaves and a slightly milder flavor.

Green Butter, Red Butter, Green Oakleaf, and Red Oakleaf

These cored types increase the flavor, color, and overall elegance of a salad mix. One quick cut with a knife and heads easily fall into uniform, individual leaves

Green Incised, Red Incised, Green Sweet Crisp, Red Sweet Crisp

Romaine-like sweet flavor with iceberg-like crisp, crunchy texture. This collection will add not only great flavor, but will increase the loft and weight of a salad mix.

New Red Fire

Produces an impressive loose leaf head, excellent for the specialty market or gourmet restaurant. Crisp and sweet.

Butterhead Lettuce

Beautiful, large, dark red heads with nicely contrasting green centers. Excellent flavor and texture.

Herbs

Lemon Basil

Sweet and tangy lemon basil. Very bright green, 2 1/2" long leaves with white blooms make this basil both attractive and intensely flavorful.

Thai Basil

Authentic Thai basil flavor. Try it as a flavorful garnish for sweet dishes. Green, 2" long leaves have a spicy, anise-clove flavor. Attractive purple stems and blooms. Called "Horapha" in its mother country. Edible Flowers: Use the flowers in any recipe that calls for basil, or to garnish drinks, salads, soups, pasta, and desserts. Intense flavor.

Italian Large Leaf Basil

Fragrant, flavorful, with extra-large leaves. This Genovese-type is essential for Neapolitan cuisine.
