SAFETY SPOTLIGHT: NIGHT WORK

Night shifts require an extra level of awareness. High-visibility gear is non-negotiable, and proper lighting—whether it's headlamps, towers, or reflective devices—makes all the difference. Cone placement and tapers are critical to protecting both workers and drivers, and they need to be set up correctly every single time.

Fatigue can sneak up during these longer shifts, so be mindful of your own limits. Stay hydrated, take short resets when needed, and don't hesitate to speak up if you're feeling drained. Your alertness keeps the entire crew safe.
