




Requirements

Visitor Visa Requirements


Canada opened its border to citizens of all countries around the world on Sep 7.
Only those who are fully vaccinated can enter Canada.


- Proof of full vaccination

Requirements for admission


- Application to a Designated Learning Institution (DLI) - Canadian university or college.
- Proof of previous education completed
- English language test
- Passport copy
- Application fees






Designated Educational Institution (DLI)

- A list of institutions that International students may attend
- Completing a program at a DLI opens doors for students to Canadian work experience and permanent residence opportunities.



Requirements for a study permit

- Admission letter to a Canadian university or college.
- Study plan
- Account statements
- Passport copy and photos
- Processing fees




