COVID –19 Update MOVED TO PHASE 2

SEPTEMBER 25TH WE MOVED INTO PHASE 2
OF OUR REOPENING PLAN!
The following is what phase 2 means for LCNH.

Residents can leave their rooms and we can have small group activities providing that we can have proper social distancing of 6 feet between everyone and everyone must be wearing a mask.

The outdoor visiting area is open and we have opened back up our indoor visitation area. You can schedule visitation with your loved ones with the Life Enhancement Department (anyone visiting must be screened in and wear a mask).

The rules and regulations for visits can change at any time and if changes are made we will do our best to keep you informed of those changes.

At this time each Resident can only have 2 people designated as visitors for indoor visitation and those 2 people have to stay the same throughout the entirety of Phase 2. In compassionate care situations residents may have more than the 2 designated indoor visitors but no more than 2 at a time.

As we go into colder months please keep in mind that the Outdoor visitation areas will be open weather permitting that we are able to keep everyone a safe as possible during this pandemic.
