## Road Closure B6138 The Cragg Challenge



## Information for Residents - Sunday 30th April 2023

The day is nearly with us. Here are some reminders and last minute details.

- 1. The closure is the B6138 from outside 32 Cragg Road to the top at Blackstone Edge (A58 junction). All other roads in this area will be open as usual except for their junctions with the B6138. The full text of the closure order is posted at each of these junctions. Access to Craggies from Mytholmroyd can be made via Scout Road and High Stones Road.
- 2. The road closure is NOT a clearway, you are not required to move your vehicle from its normal parking spot. However, if you can park your vehicle off the road it would be helpful.
- 3. The road is closed to ALL vehicles except authorised vehicles between 8.30am and 12.30pm.
- 4. Essential access for vehicles escorted by an authorised vehicle will allow movement in/out of the road closure. This movement will be limited to approx. 15mph and competitors on the course will take priority. If you need escorted access please contact us before the day (see below).
- 5. Emergency services will have access as and when they require it.
- 6. Events are happening throughout the morning (see below). The times quoted for events are the planned times subject to change according to circumstances on the day.

08.30	Road closes, no unauthorised, or unescorted, vehicles on the road after this time.
08.30	John Jones Dash (1 mile) board trailing bus for transport to start line near Robin Hood Oliver Collinge Climb participants board the leading bus for drop off above 1km point (approx)
08.35	Oliver Collinge Climb starts at Royd Ices
08.45	John Jones Dash starts from Start line near Robin Hood
09.05	John jones Dash finishes at Royd Ices
09.10	10 Mile run starts followed by 10Km run and 5Km run
11.10	Runs completed, medal and prize ceremonies
11.10	Cycle Ascent starts
12.00	Cycle ascent finishes
12.30	Road reopens - it is hoped to be able reopen by 12.00, if it is safe to do so
13.30	Clear-up complete
