## Morningside Security GroupMe Alerts

with reports last year of auto break-ins, we are now using the GroupMe app to share important information on neighborhood security incidents. You can receive the Morningside Security GroupMe alerts in two ways.

1-You can download the GroupMe app and receive messages inside the app

2-You can request to be added to the text message chain, and the alerts will show up just like a normal text message.

To be added via standard text messages please email the cell phone number you would like to receive the alerts on to: comm@morningside-senoia.com or Download the app on your smartphone. You can find the app on the App Store if you have an iPhone or the Google Play Store if you have an Android.

Once installed you will create your own account. Then contact us at comm@morningside-senoia.com to receive a QR Code to join the group.

- This group is for suspicious activity only. Please do not report missing animals or neighborhood announcements. We have other outlets for this sort of information. (i.e. Facebook)
- Please limit post to activity only. This is a large group so please limit responses to essential information. It is not necessary to respond to each post unless you have additional pertinent information. Irrelevant responses such as, OK, Thanks! or "I'll keep an eye out" are discouraged.
