



On Behalf of the Sioux Lookout Local Education Group (SLLEG), we would like to invite you to apply to become a Faculty Member with NOSM. In order to become a member of the SLLEG you must obtain NOSM faculty status. Please submit your application directly to NOSM. Then send me an email letting me know you have submitted so I can monitor.

There are essentially 2 stages to become a LEG member; (NOSM, NOAMA)

The **first step** is to complete the NOSM Faculty application, Letter of Intent, CV, Direct Deposit form with copy of void cheque and signed D&C.

You **must** fill out a Declaration & Consent (D&C). There are two choices incorporated and unincorporated.

Once you are approved by NOSM, then the signed D&C forms enable you to become a member of the PCTA (Physician Clinical Teacher Association). As long as you have designated Sioux Lookout as your 'practice site' on the NOSM application, then NOAMA (Northern Ontario Academic Medical Association) includes you in the group of physicians for whom we receive some per-capita funding.

On Page 11 – there is a link for your Curriculum Vitae (CV). Please follow this link as it is much easier to complete.

Letter of Teaching Intent

It was explained to me that it is simply a drafted letter by you stating,

- 1) You are living/practicing in Sioux Lookout or wherever
- 2) Have been involved in teaching Phase 2 learners and residents
- 3) You are a family medicine physician
- 4) You are going to continue as an appointed faculty member
- 5) If you are or have been involved in any research projects

6) List anything you intend on proceeding with in the future

I have also attached the new AFP Agreement between the Ministry and NOSM, NOAMA, OMA and PCTA for you to review if you wish.

Once the application is received, it will go through many desks which can take some time (up to 6 months). So please be patient. We ask that you fill out everything correctly in order for the process to proceed in a timely fashion.

Second Step

Once approved, you will receive a “Letter of Offer” from NOSM. This will automatically make you a PCTA (Physician Clinical Teachers Association) member. Once received, please forward a copy of the letter of offer to LEG Administrator, Linda McNaughton to keep on file at email lmcnaughton@slmhc.on.ca
