## Lesson 1: Number Keypad: 4, 5, and 6 Keys

[Matthew 10:30, "And even the very hairs of your head are all numbered."]
Allow your left hand to hover over the keyboard. You will need to use your left thumb to press the spacebar. Use your right index finger (J) for typing the four (4), the right middle finger (K) for typing the five (5), and the right ring finger for typing the six (6). This is considered the home row for the numeric keypad.

A. Type the $\mathbf{4}$ in sets of three 10 times as shown below:

B. Type the 5 in sets of three 10 times as shown below:

C. Type the $\mathbf{6}$ in sets of three 10 times as shown below:

D. Type the 4, 5 and $\mathbf{6}$ in sets of three 10 times as shown below:

E. Type the 4, 5 and $\mathbf{6}$ in sets of three as displayed pressing Enter with your right pinky (on the numeric keypad) at the end of each line (typed as one column not two):

## Lesson 2: Number Keypad: 1, 2, and 3 Keys

[Matthew 10:30, "And even the very hairs of your head are all numbered."]
Allow your left hand to hover over the keyboard. You will need to use your left thumb to press the spacebar. Use your right index finger (J) for typing the one (1), the right middle finger (K) for typing the two (2), and the right ring finger for typing the three (3).
A. Type the $\mathbf{1}$ in sets of three 10 times as shown below:

B. Type the $\mathbf{2}$ in sets of three 10 times as shown below:

C. Type the 3 in sets of three 10 times as shown below:

D. Type the 1, 2 and $\mathbf{3}$ in sets of three 10 times as shown below:

E. Type the 1, 2 and $\mathbf{3}$ in sets of three as displayed pressing Enter with your right pinky (on the numeric keypad) at the end of each line (typed as one column not two):

## Lesson 3: Number Keypad: 7, 8, and 9 Keys

[Matthew 10:30, "And even the very hairs of your head are all numbered."]
Allow your left hand to hover over the keyboard. You will need to use your left thumb to press the spacebar. Use your right index finger (J) for typing the seven (7), the right middle finger ( $K$ ) for typing the eight (8), and the right ring finger for typing the nine (9).
A. Type the 7 in sets of three 10 times as shown below:

B. Type the $\mathbf{8}$ in sets of three 10 times as shown below:

C. Type the $\mathbf{9}$ in sets of three 10 times as shown below:

D. Type the 7,8 and 9 in sets of three 10 times as shown below:

E. Type the 7, 8 and 9 in sets of three as displayed pressing Enter with your right pinky (on the numeric keypad) at the end of each line (typed as one column not two):

## Lesson 4: Number Keypad: 0 and . Keys and Review

[Matthew 10:30, "And even the very hairs of your head are all numbered."]
Allow your left hand to hover over the keyboard. You will need to use your left thumb to press the spacebar. Use your right index finger (J) for typing the zero (0), and the right ring finger for typing the decimal (.).
A. Type the $\mathbf{0}$ in sets of three 10 times as shown below:

B. Type the . in sets of three 10 times as shown below:
C. Type the $\mathbf{0}$ and . in sets of three 10 times as shown below:

D. Type the sets of numbers as displayed pressing Enter with your right pinky (on the numeric keypad) at the end of each line (typed as one column not two):
