



## Soap Making and Bath Bomb Tips

- **Bath Bombs** - use Polysorbate 80 to help prevent tub staining and help disperse micas
- **Mica in Bath Bombs** – mica will add color & shimmer to your bathtub water, D&C dyes can help color the water also
- **Yellow mica** in soap making will turn Orange for a short period of time during Saponification
- **Blue and Green** micas are not recommended for use in Bath Bombs
- **Bath Bombs** - blooming your micas, will create more vibrant colors
- **Olive oil** used in Soap recipes, could create a yellowish green tint
- **Gelling** your CP soaps can force the mica colors to become brighter and more vibrant
- **Blue mica** may react with Citric Acid in Bath Bombs, creating a temporary Sulphur smell
- **Safety** - please wear eye, breathing and hand protection when making bath products
- **Fragrance Oils** can discolor your mica. Especially fragrance oils that have vanillin
- **Melt and Pour Soaps** - disperse micas in RA first to prevent clumping
