Attaches to a skid steer or any other machine equipped with the Universal Quick Tach' mounting system.

Rotates 127 degrees to the operator's left when attached to an EZ Spot UR Double Cylinder Rotating Base.

Can also be attached to an EZ Spot UR Fixed Non-Rotating Base.

Jaws will open to 27 inches and close completely down to 0.

Composed of Grade 50 material or higher and core welded to withstand years of wear and tear.

450 lb. toolhead weight, 882 lb. attachment weight with the Double Cylinder Rotating Base.

One 3" x 6" hydraulic clamp cylinder confidently opens and closes the jaws of the attachment and ensure a solid grip throughout. Cylinder breakout force is 21,206 lbs.

The tips of the jaws close completely but there will be 13 inches of clearance in the middle of the attachment when the jaws are closed.

Jaws are 43 inches wide from end to end.

Comes complete with flush faced couplers, spring hose mount, and wiring harness.
