

Ekklesia: Greek word translated as church. Means assembly or congregation, but frequently did not refer to a building but rather referred to people.

- Ekklesia: Greek word translated as church.
- When referring to a people in the Book of Acts
 - Jews or Gentiles who placed their faith in Jesus **Christ and received the Holy Spirit following** Pentecost in Acts 2.
