# God's Power UNCERTAIN

#### God's Promise

- And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose. Rom. 8:28
  - · Not some things.
  - · Work for the good.
  - · Exclusive Promise.



### God's Promise of Prayer



- · Without the aid of the Spirit,
  - · Even our prayers of would fail.
    - · Even with God, Christians are weak.
    - Ye ask, and receive not, because ye ask amiss, that ye may consume it upon your lusts. James 4:3



- Remedy to this weakness is the Spirit's intervention and assistance.
  - · Overcomes our own limitations
  - Demonstrates that even in petition we need the Lord's help.



• 26 Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered. Romans 8.26



- Paul recognizes the Holy Spirit interceding with the Father on behalf of weak Christians.
  - · Holy Spirit pleads our cause with the Father,
    - · Even helping us to formulate our prayers.
    - Holy Spirit is the source of all genuine Christian prayer.



- · Spirit's help includes all communion with God:
  - Doxology, blessing, praise, thanksgiving, penitent confession, supplication, or any acknowledgment of God as Father (8:15) and of Jesus as Lord (1 Cor 12:3b).
- · Holy Spirit essential to communion with God!
  - · Prayer powerful aid to the believer!



- Confess your faults one to another, and pray one for another, that ye may be healed. The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much.

  James 5:16
  - The prayer of the righteous is very powerful in its working (5:16b).



#### Righteousness

- Sounds daunting but shouldn't threaten you!
  - · We have been justified by faith
  - We stand before God with a righteousness that is not our own.



- Not our Righteousness
  - ...for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, being justified as a gift by His grace through the redemption which is in Christ Jesus. Rom. 3:23-24
  - · To be justified is to be declared righteous.



#### Righteousness

- · But it also refers to our walk.
- · Does not imply perfection.
- · Rather, means to walk uprightly before God.
  - · To judge and confess all known sin
  - · To seek to obey God in every area of life.



- Power of Prayer as Powerful as the God to whom we pray.
- · There is no inherent power in prayer itself.
- Instead, prayer links us to God who is omnipotent.



- · Prayer is not just wishful thinking.
  - When we pray, we speak to the Almighty
     Creator of heaven and earth,
  - · Prayer can do anything that God can do!



- · What about unanswered prayers?
  - Sometimes God delays the answers we seek to keep us in humble dependence on Him.
  - Paul's thorn in the flesh is an example (2 Cor. 12:7-10).



- · What about unanswered prayers?
  - · Elijah prayed for God to send rain
  - · God had promised to send rain, but
  - · God did not answer instantly.
  - It took seven attempts on Elijah's part before the first cloud was seen in the sky.



- Sometimes God answers no for His own reasons.
  - · We have trust God and God's omniscient ways.
- The danger is that when we encounter God's delays or denials of our requests, we will lose heart and give up praying.
  - But we must not lose faith in God!



 We should pray big prayers and expect God to accomplish much through them, according to His purpose and glory.



- Prayer is available to believers in every time and in every place.
  - Power of prayer not limited to prayers offered in church buildings on Sunday mornings,
  - · Or to prayers offered by pastors or leaders.
  - · Or prayers in eloquent language.



- · If you know Christ, then
  - · Wherever you are,
  - · Whatever need you find yourself,
  - You can call on God and God will hear and answer according to God's will.



- · God doesn't weigh the value of the prayers
  - · By their length
  - · Or by how many people get together to pray
  - · Or by how much you agonize in your prayers.
    - Even if you've only got a few minutes, you can still devote the time to prayer!
