

The premise is simple: A podcast about Gresham history, told through the voices of those who have lived it.

At 10 episodes in, <u>Voices of Gresham</u> is bringing local history alive – the beautiful, the humorous, and the challenging – with stories that are relevant in the present day. Season 1 tackled the World War II imprisonment of Japanese residents, struggles of women in the workplace, and our changing environment. Season 2 will focus on migrations, the library, and Gresham's musical heritage.

SEASON 2 EPISODES

Episode names and descriptions may change as production moves forward. This list is intended to give an idea of the general scope of each episode. We invite you to connect with Silvie Andrews at sandrews@greshamhistorical.org for more information on sponsoring specific episodes.

MAIN ARC: COMING TO GRESHAM (5 EPISODES)

1850S: THE OREGON TRAIL

Indigenous history and the arrival of settlers; the start of "Gresham."

1890S-1930S: WORK AND SURVIVAL

More newcomers arrive to work in local industry and to escape hardship at home.

1940S-1960S: WAR AND POSTWAR

The Bracero program, war work, and the transition away from agriculture.

1970S-2000S: REFUGE AND GROWTH

Growth of Gresham and Rockwood; refugee settlement; controversy.

GRESHAM NOW AND IN THE FUTURE

Who lives here now? Why did they choose Gresham? What does the future hold?

EVOLUTION OF LIVE MUSIC (3 EPISODES)

BALLROOMS AND DANCE HALLS

Early dance venues – and moral panic around dancing and alcohol.

ROCK CLUBS AND HONKY TONK BARS

Several local bars hosted nationally touring groups in the 1940s-70s.

STADIUM CONCERTS AND FESTIVALS

The Mt. Hood Jazz Festival, Edgefield concerts, and the current music scene.

GRESHAM LIBRARIES (2 EPISODES)

A LIBRARY FOR GRESHAM

The humble origins of the Gresham Library and how it grew in the early 1900s.

BOOK BRIGADES AND MEGABRANCHES

New libraries in 1989 and 2026; the role of libraries in the modern age.
