★ 1. Executive Summary

Las Vegas faces an intertwined crisis of homelessness, food insecurity, and economic vulnerability. The establishment of the Olive Tree Micro-Farms™ Foundation offers a bold, locally rooted response—while also laying the groundwork for a mercy infrastructure capable of expanding far beyond Nevada.

This seed investment will empower us to build a year-round, sustainable, replicable micro-farm model that:

- feeds the hungry first,
- trains and employs the homeless,
- reduces dependence on unstable food pipelines,

- restores dignity through skill-building, and
- creates a surplus of abundance for the entire community.

And when the time comes—after the first farms bloom, the first trainees thrive, and the first neighborhoods are visibly transformed—the Olive Tree Micro-Farms™ Foundation will stand ready to develop into an expanding global enterprise of mercy, positioned to stand shoulder-to-shoulder with the His Eyes Foundation as a co-founder of similar foundations in cities across the world.

Not replacing His Eyes.

Not competing with His Eyes.

But joining His Eyes:

as a partner, a peer, and a fellow planter in the worldwide orchard of mercy that God continues to grow and grow and grow.

This seed grant does not fund dependency— This one-time grant funds multiplication.

It plants the first olive tree of a movement capable of feeding bodies, restoring souls, and renewing cities... **4EVER!**

2. Statement of Need

A. Homelessness in Las Vegas

Las Vegas consistently ranks near the top of U.S. cities in per-capita homelessness. Thousands survive nightly without secure shelter, steady income, or meaningful access to healthy food.

B. Fresh Food Scarcity in the Desert

The Las Vegas Valley is both a geographical desert **and** a food desert:

- Fresh produce is expensive
- Water for agriculture is scarce
- Many neighborhoods lack accessible greens entirely

C. Cycles of Vulnerability

Heat, hunger, unstable income, and trauma reinforce one another, forming downward spirals that rarely reverse without **innovative**, **pattern-breaking**, **dignity-restoring interventions**.

Adding insult to injury:

those who most need nutritious food, training, connection, and mercy are often the least likely to have access to them.

3. Project Overview: The Olive Tree Micro-Farms™ Solution

Olive Tree Micro-Farms™ introduces compact, high-yield, year-round vertical farming systems that convert courtyards, vacant lots, underused parking areas, or small derelict buildings into sustainable, mercy-driven production engines—each one intentionally designed to HELP MERCY ABOUND.

A. Vertical Micro-Farm Capabilities

Each unit is designed to:

- use 90–95% less water
- operate year-round
- produce 3,000–6,000 heads of lettuce (or similar greens) monthly
- generate hundreds of trays of microgreens

thrive in intense desert climates

B. Feeding the Homeless First

Harvests will immediately support:

- · Epicenter on the Parkway free-meal production
- Street outreach teams
- · Weekly motel residents
- · Newly sheltered individuals
- Deliveries by LyftMobile[™] drivers when off duty

C. Workforce Development

Participants will receive training in:

- hydroponics & horticulture
- plant nutrition & climate control
- food handling & safety
- packaging & distribution
- · teamwork & leadership

This builds a pathway to employment, not merely a volunteer opportunity.

And in that courtyard, thriving in the desert heat, are **olive trees**— echoing Gethsemane, where Jesus prayed:

"Not my will, but Thine, O Father."

In this sacred overlap of ancient symbolism and modern need—in the parking lot beside the Olive Tree Prayer Garden—our first **Olive Tree Micro-Farm™** will take root.
