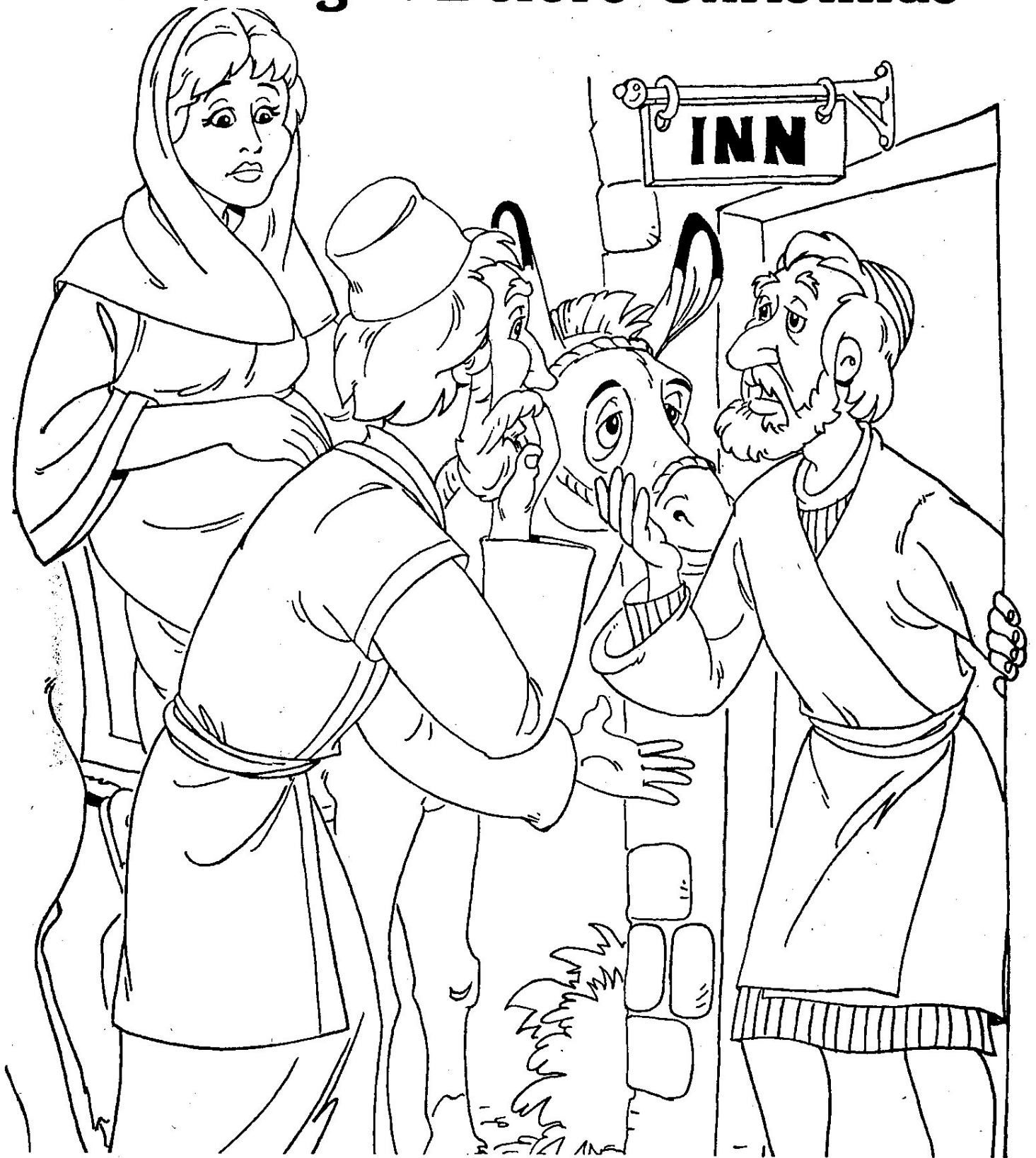
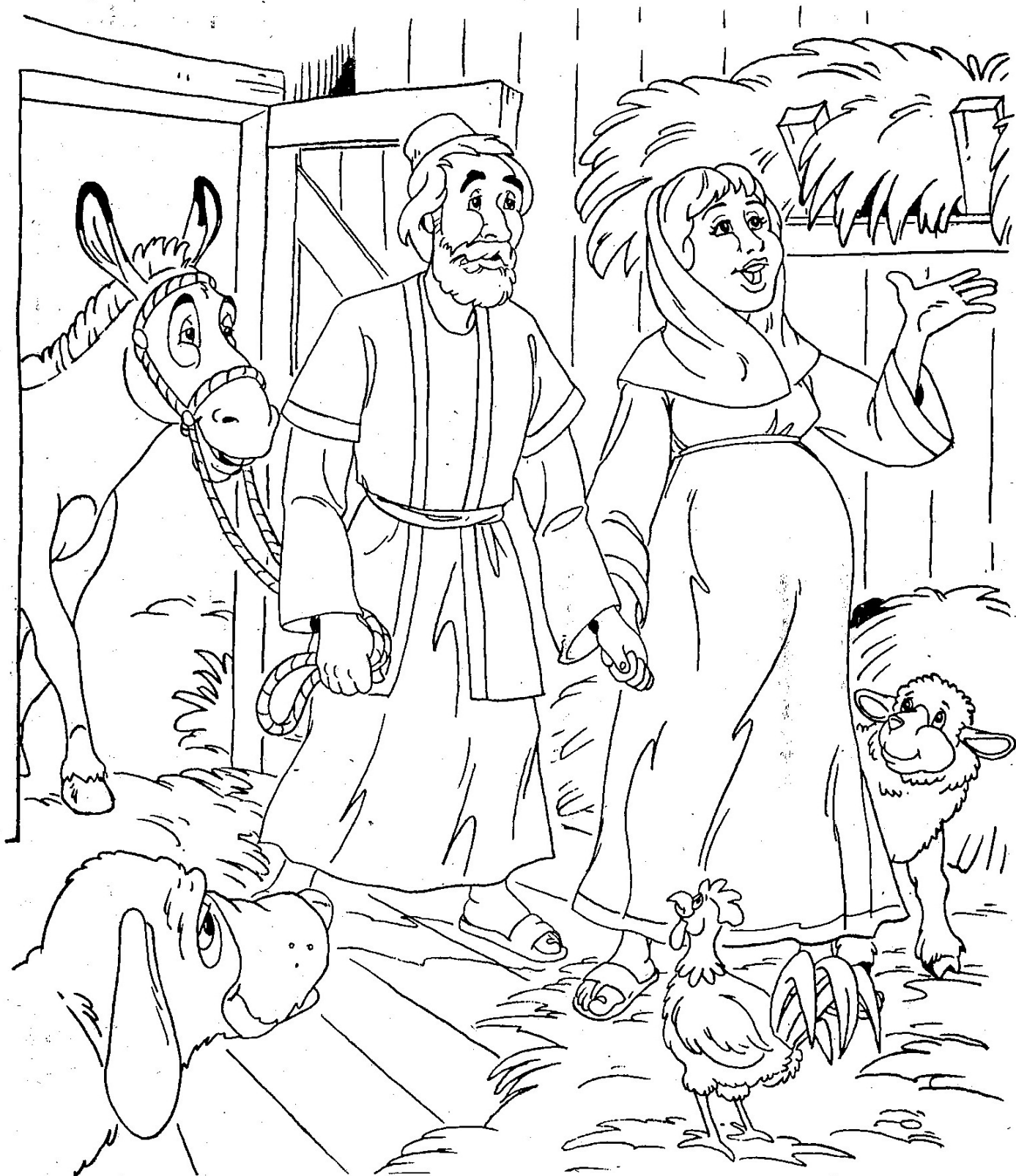


The Night Before Christmas
