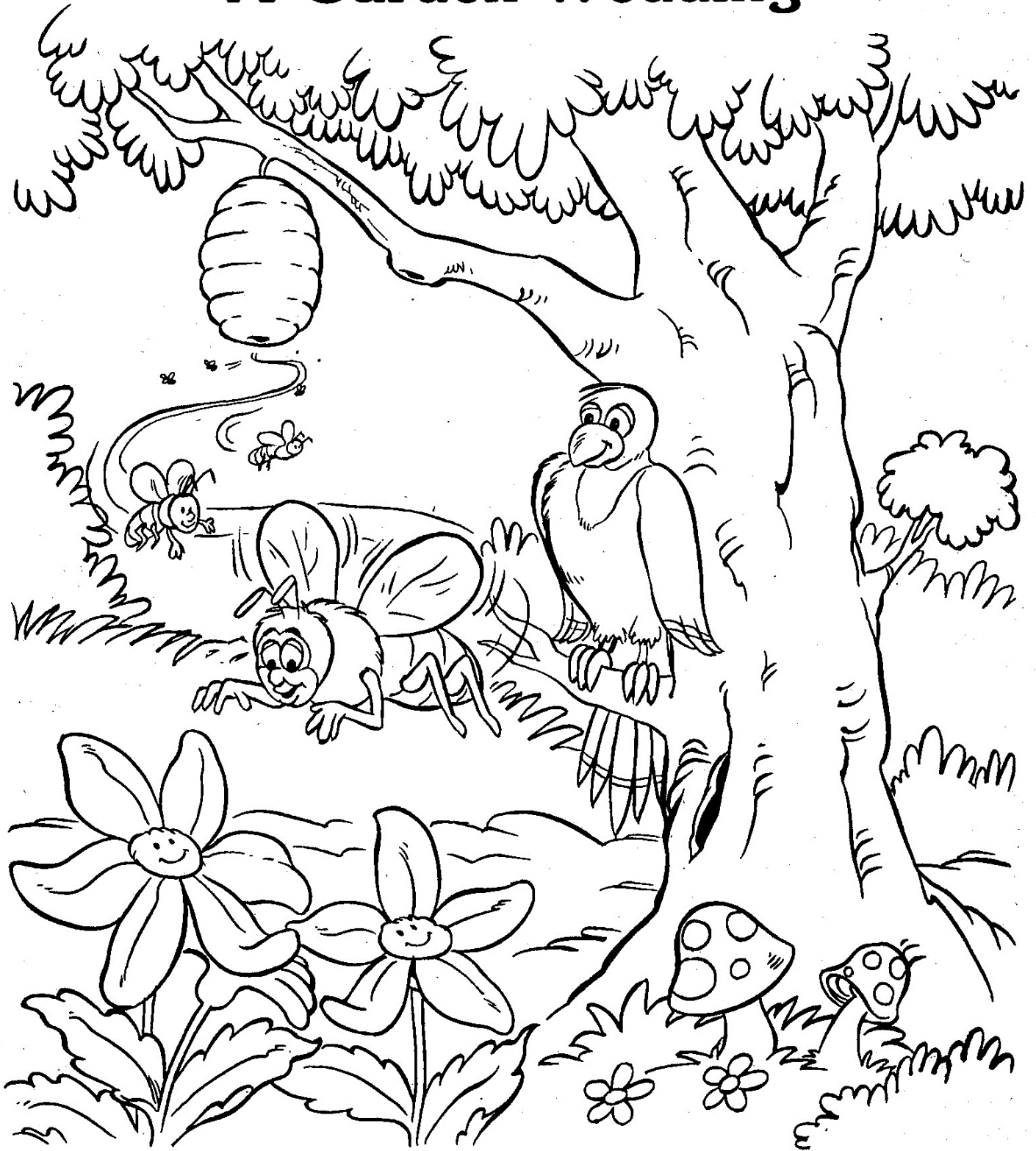


# A Garden Wedding

He gave it to Adam, and put him in charge.



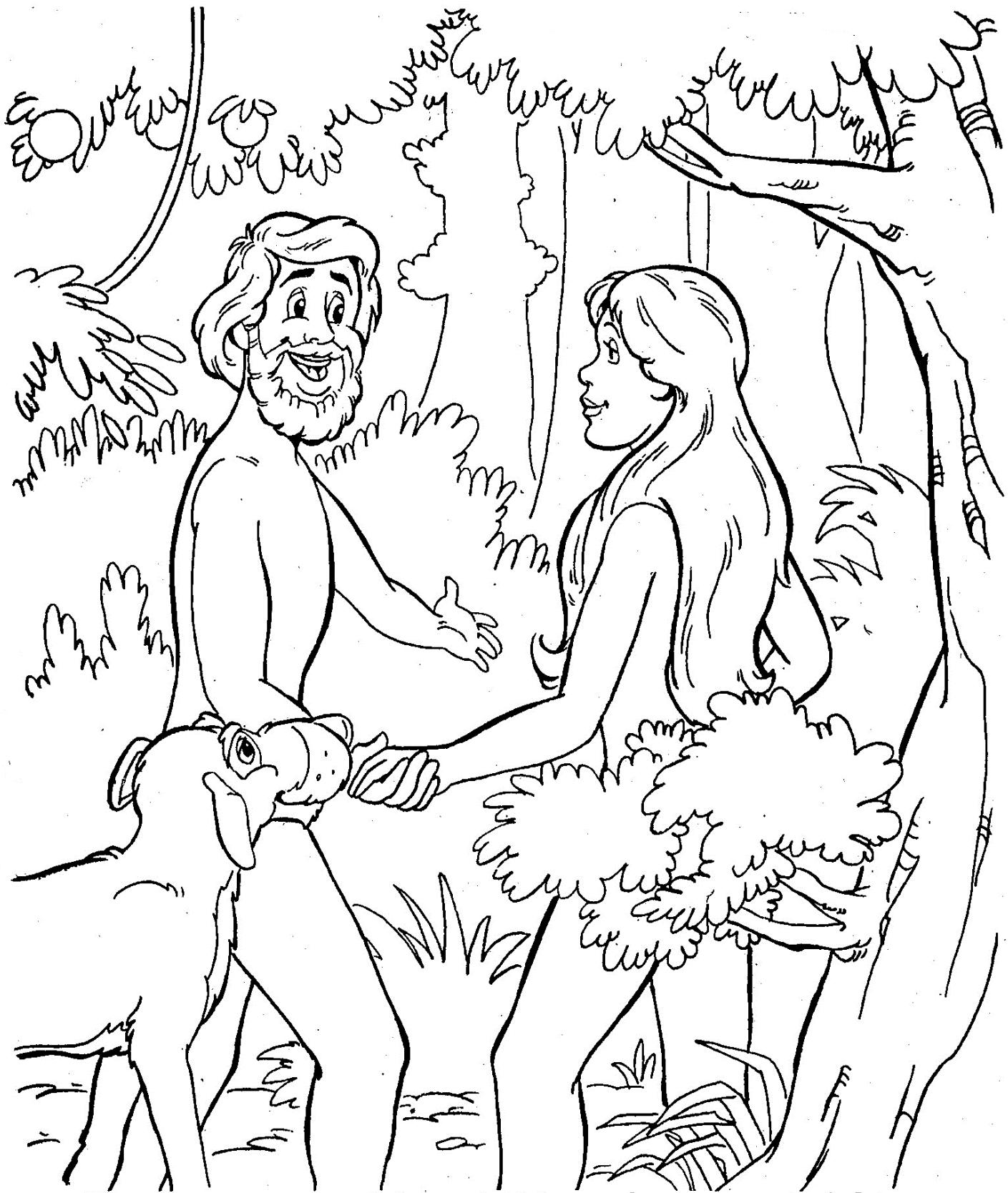
Adam gave names to the things God had made.
