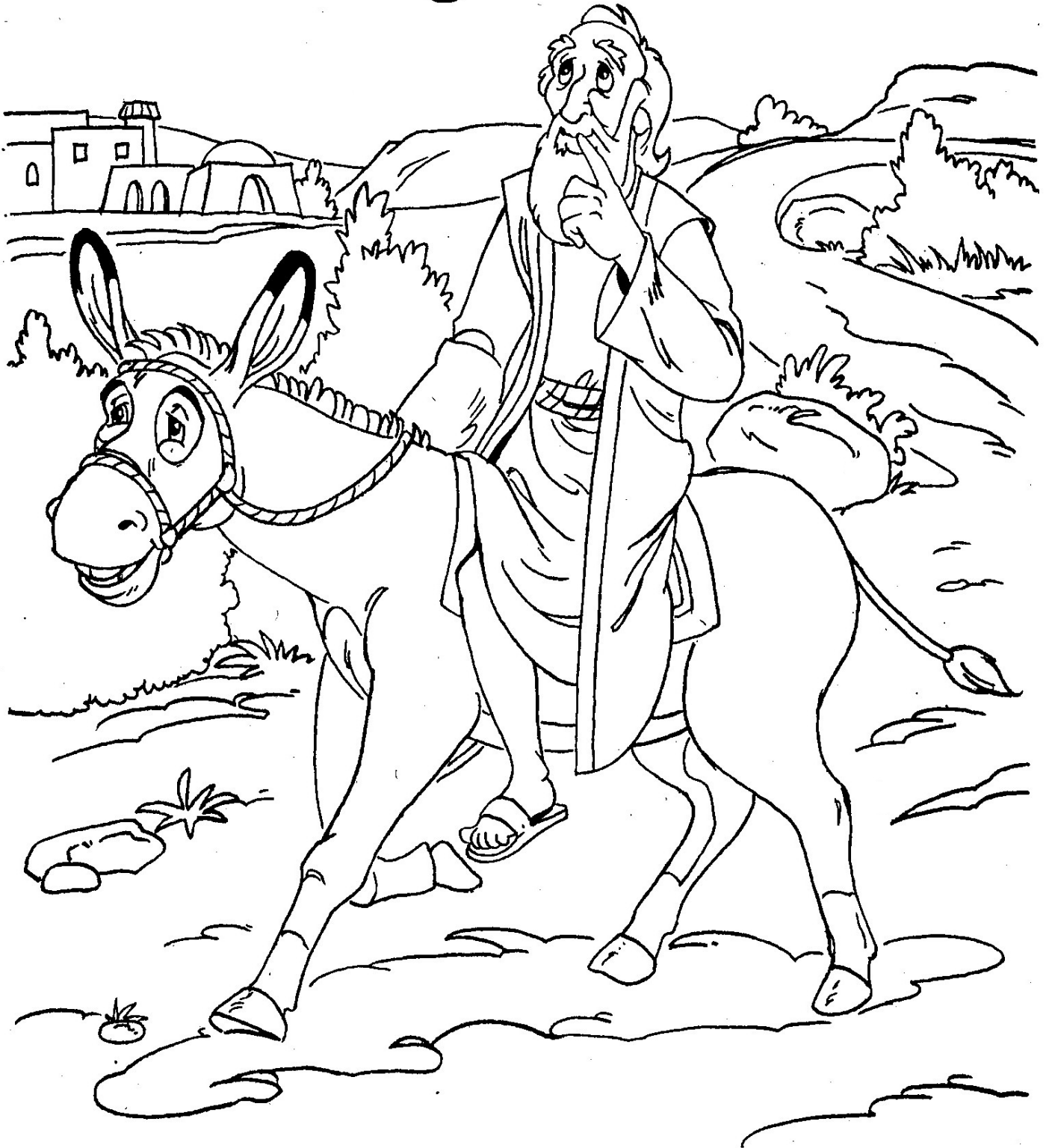


Knowing God's Voice

He planned what he would say.



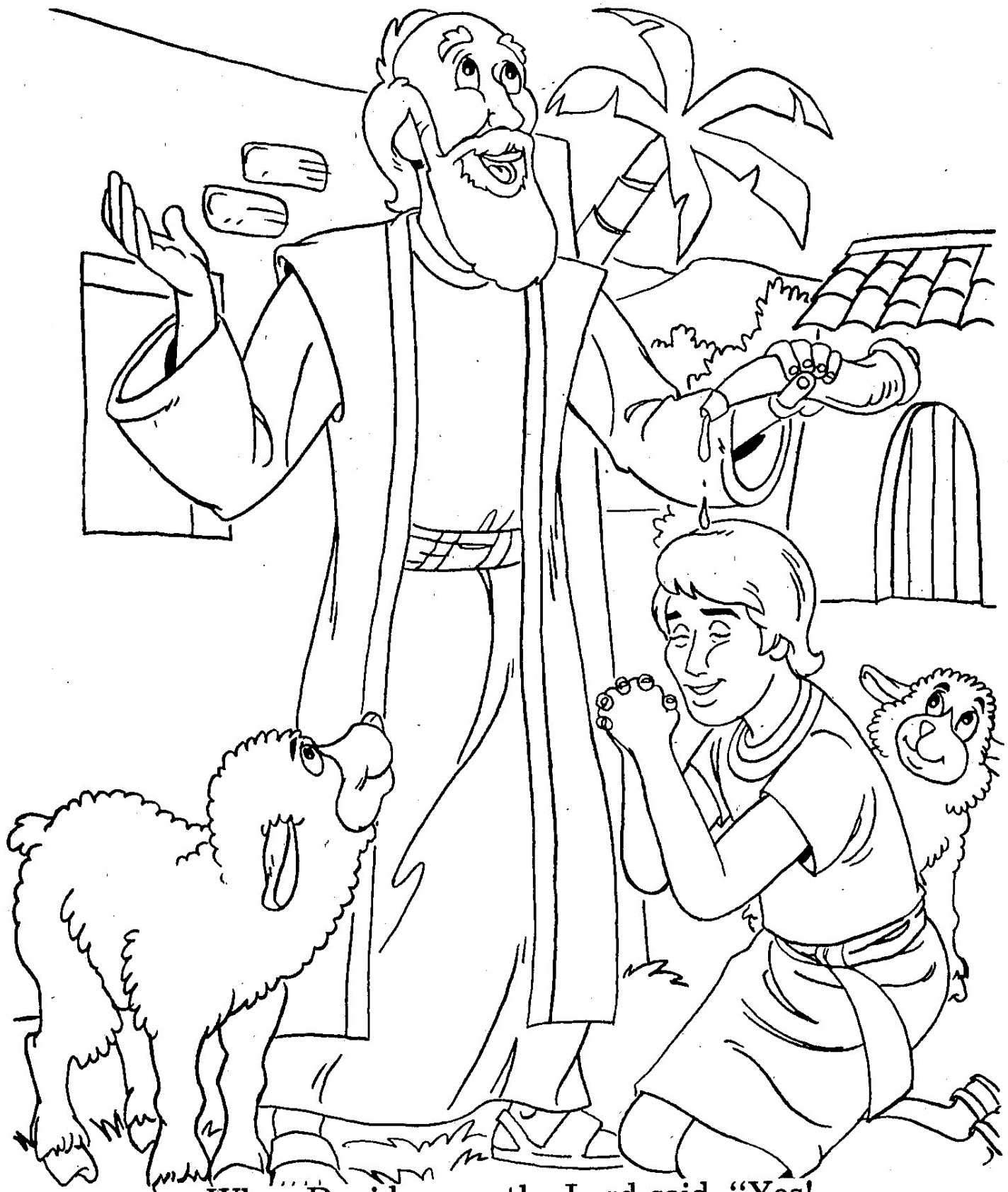
**"Jesse, tell your sons to come,
