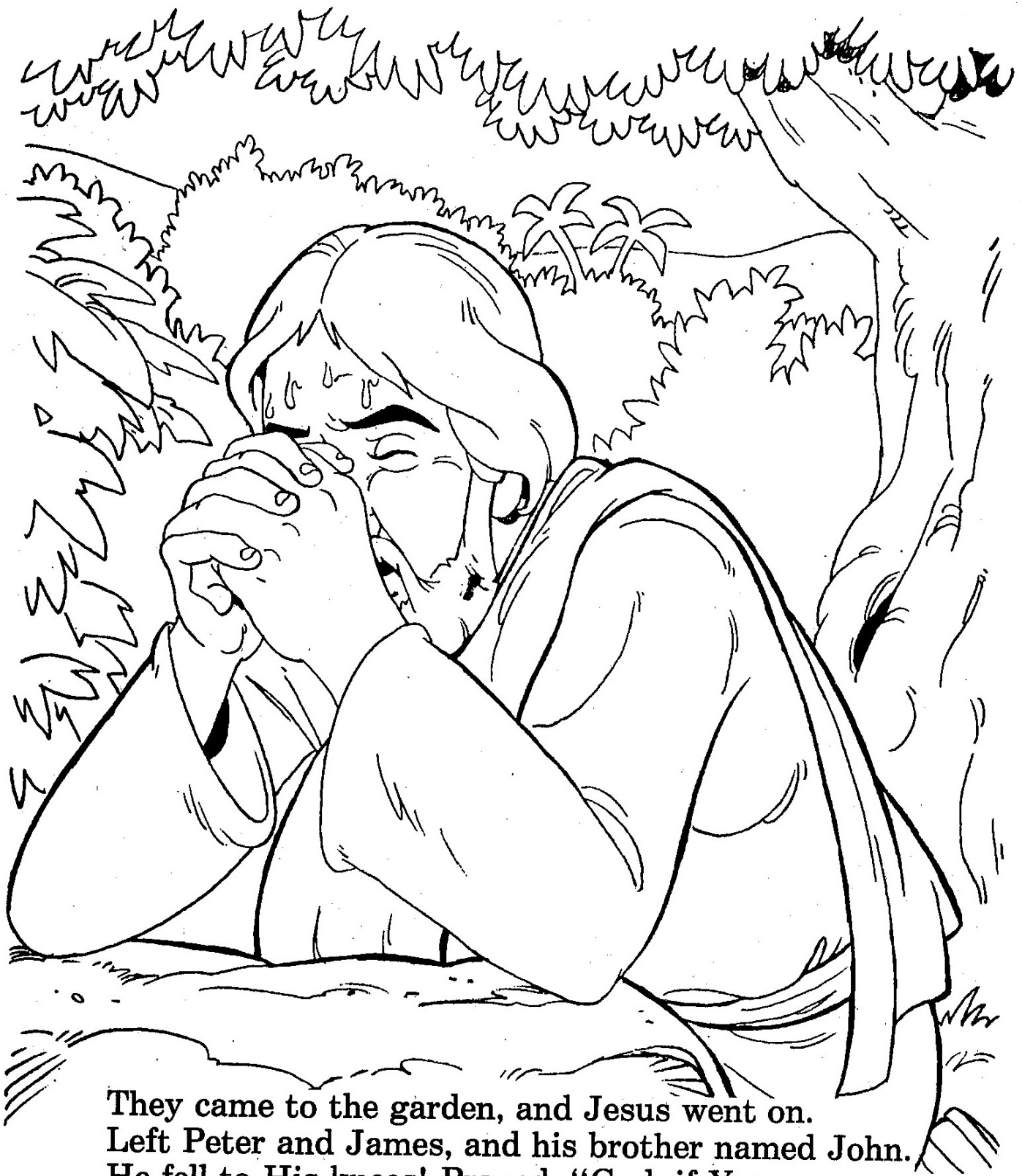


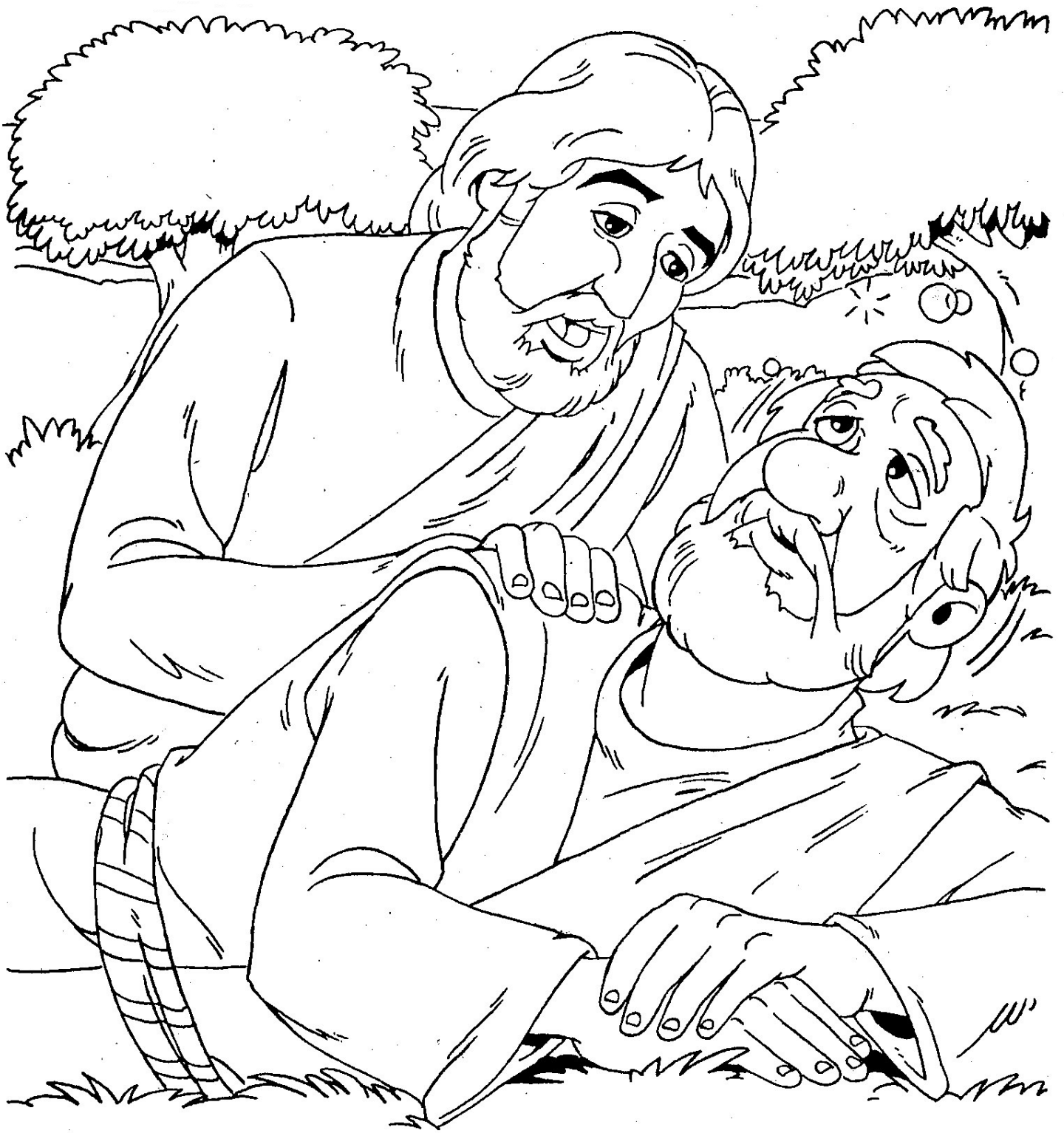
Betrayed
