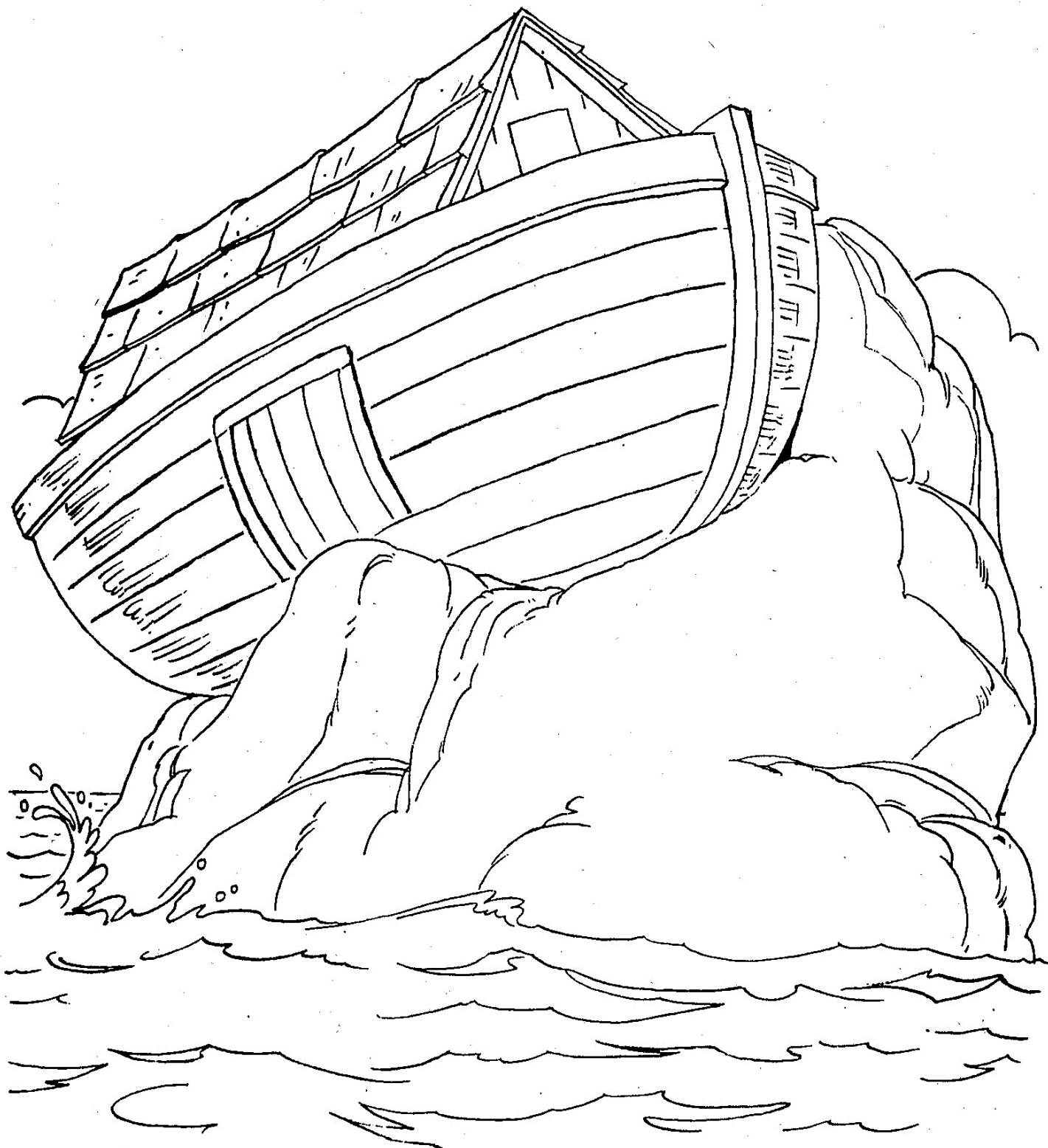
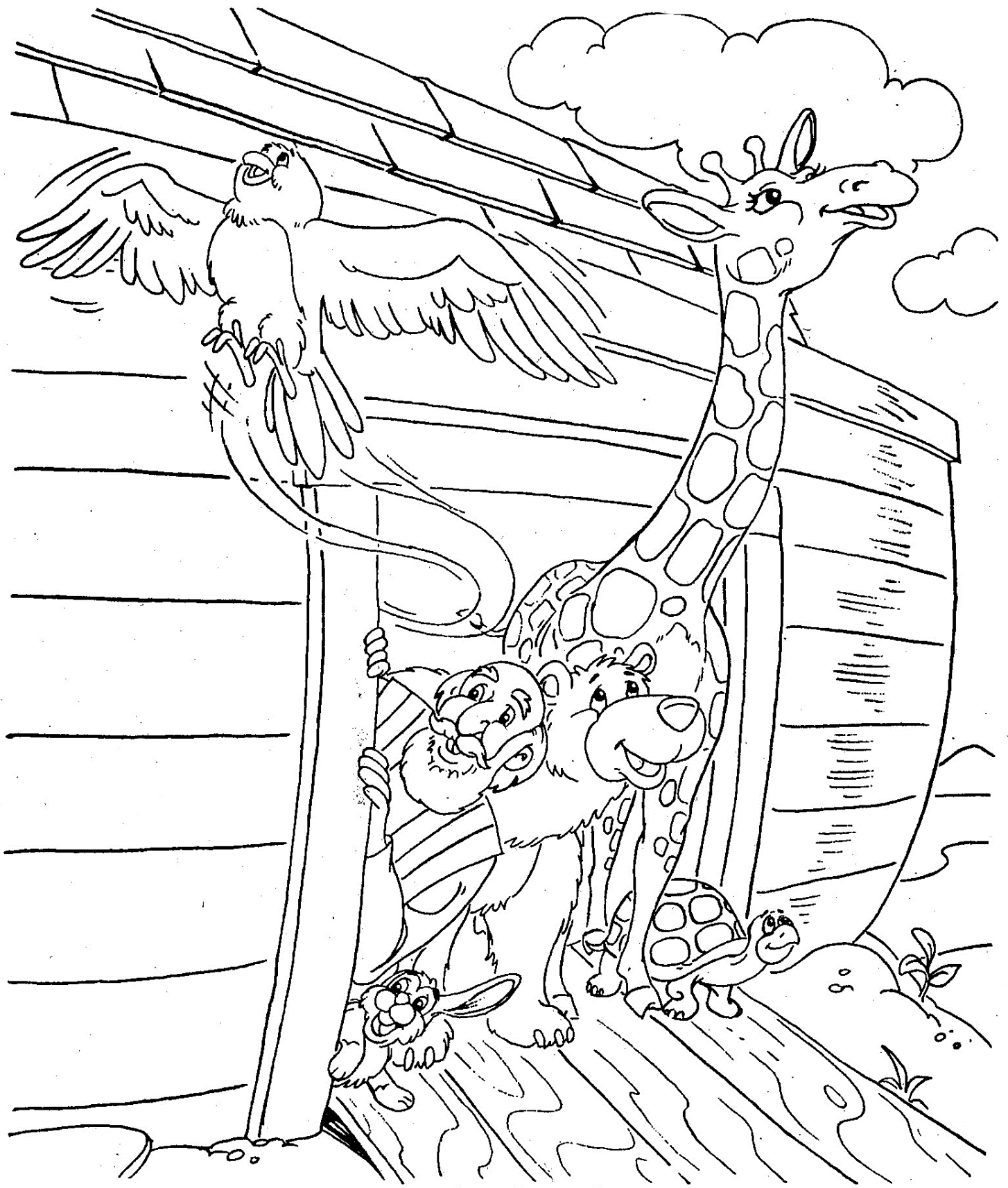


Noah's Cruise



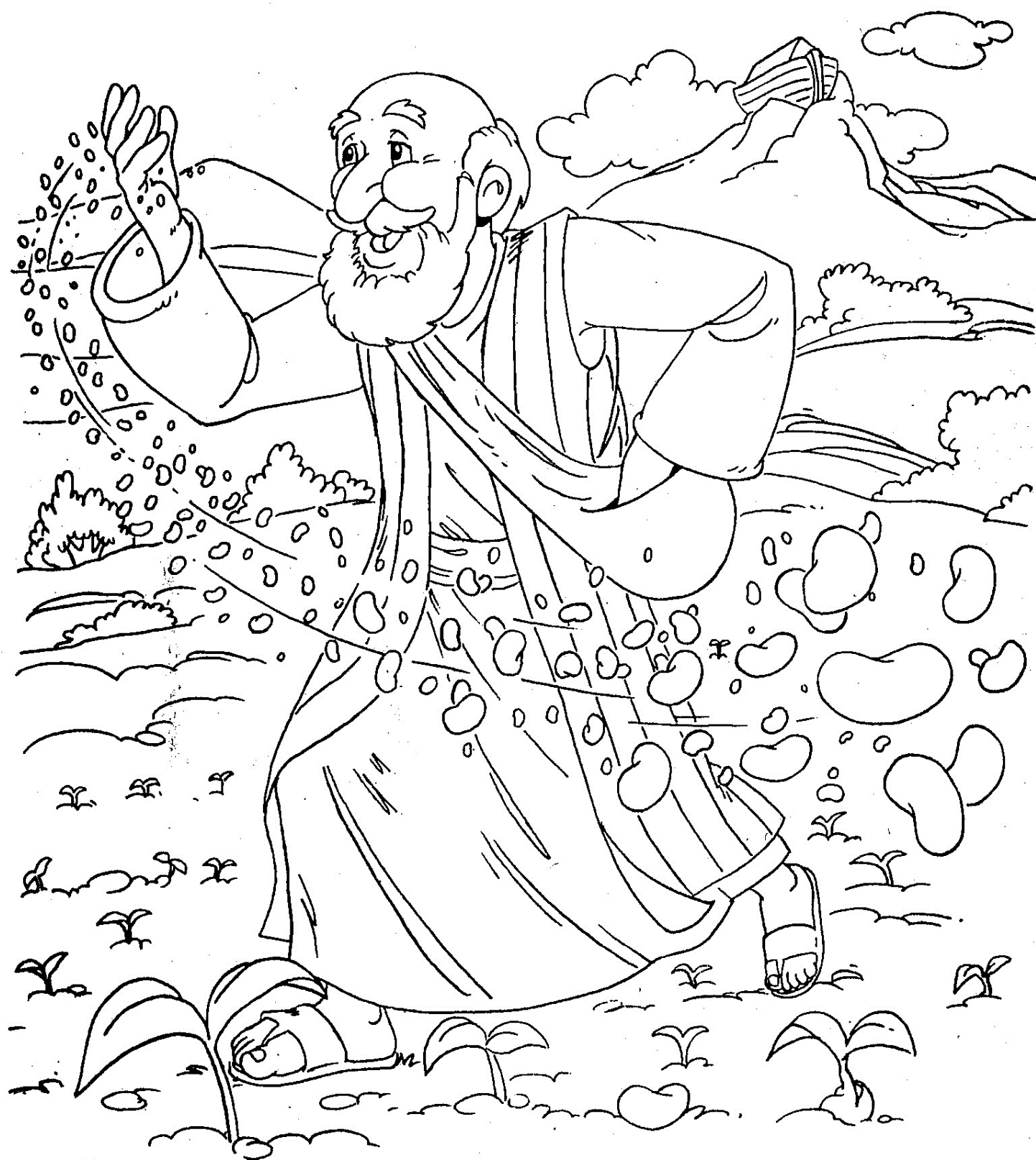
The floating zoo brought Noah through
