

# Alabama Jewelers Association Design Competition Rules of Entry

## Eligibility

You must be a 2020 Alabama Jewelers Association (AJA) member to enter the annual Design Competition. Entry Fee (\$25) is waived for first-time entrants. Fee applies to all other entries with payment due prior to judging. Jewelry Design students currently enrolled at a state college or university are eligible to enter with no fee.

## Rules of Entry

- **Pieces must be original designs created by the person entering the contest**
- All entries must be completed pieces, made within the past year
- Pieces cannot have been mass produced – “one of a kind designs” preferred
- Pieces should not be identified or hallmarked until after the judging
- Displays must be provided Jeweler entering the piece and Displays CAN NOT have logos of any kind on them.
- Pieces must be made of precious metals or mixed with precious metals and stones used must be genuine, natural, or cultured stones. Please no Lab Created stones such as CZ, Moissanite, Lab Created Diamond, Pearl Simulant.
- AJA reserves the right to disqualify any piece which does not meet all criteria

## Details of Entry (General)

- Entrant may submit one design per category. Each piece must be submitted with a \$25 entry fee (due before judging begins).
- Entry must be at the Design Competition Desk on the morning of Sunday, April 7<sup>th</sup> at 8:30-8:45am.
- Items must be made of silver, gold or platinum, and may contain diamonds and/or colored gemstones.
- Alternative materials accepted, if the materials are suitable for retail sale
  - Category 1) Materials may cost up to \$1,000
  - Category 2) Materials may cost between \$1,001 to \$3,000
  - Category 3) Materials may cost over \$3,000
  - Cad: Cost of materials may vary

## Judging

The entries are judged & voted-on by a specifically chosen group of industry professionals. When the pieces are judged, they will be identified only by number. The criteria/considerations when voting is:

a) Creative Use of Materials, b) Overall Design, c) Feasibility of Selling Item, d) Originality, e) Fashion Merit

## Prizes for Alabama Jewelers

Special recognition plaques will be presented to 1<sup>st</sup> Place winners in each category. The “Best of Show” winner and the “Peoples’ Choice” winner will also receive a plaque – The “Peoples’ Choice” award is chosen by all convention attendees.

**Display, Judging, and Winner announcements at the AJA Annual Convention Sunday, April 19<sup>th</sup>, at The Wynfrey Hotel in Birmingham, Alabama.**

## Timetable

The **Application Form is required prior to convention, no later than April 14, 2020**. All Items must have separate entry forms. Items are to be presented with displays on the morning of April 19<sup>th</sup>. Please be advised that **it is important for the office to know of approximately how many entries and categories** (i.e. ring, bracelet, pendant) **will be entered** to allow planning time, and to ensure that all items are properly displayed and numbered for judging. Failure to fill out and submit form prior to convention could lead to the piece being disqualified. If item needs specific lighting (such as a color change gemstone), the person entering the item is responsible for special lighting

**Please be advised, following the finale speaker and before lunch, each jeweler must pick up and be responsible for their piece and display. Design Competition Committee cannot be responsible for jewelry AFTER Design Competition is complete.**
