Children should be picked up no later than 6:00 p.m. unless prior arrangements have been made.

Please remember that the **weekly tuition is due on the Friday BEFORE** the following week of attendance. If payment is not made by the preceding Friday, **a \$25 late fee will be applied per child.** 2 days or more is considered a full week. Daily rate is \$55 per day.

Welcome to the J. Park Summer Karate Camp Program! We are excited to have you train with us in the 2022 J. Park Summer Karate Camp. If you have any questions or concerns please feel free to contact me at tcarpenter26246@gmail.com or 727-796-7233. Communication is a vital key to success for all of us.

Here are some standard reminders and rules for a successful and happy Summer Camp. Please take the time to read each item. It seems many parents have not read this letter.

1. **PROGRAM:**
 - a. We will do martial arts every day, except Friday.
2. **UNIFORMS:**
 - a. Students must have a clean J. Park or Omega MMA uniform to participate in class. Please remember: martial arts is our program. Students who do not participate in class on a regular basis will not be able to continue in our program.
3. **SCHEDULE:**
 - a. Three days or more a week is considered a full week. The daily rate is \$55.00.
4. **PAYMENTS:**
 - a. ALL payments are due the Friday BEFORE the following week of attendance.
 - b. Checks are to be made out to J. Park.
 - c. We ask that you please put the week of your payment and child's name in the lower left corner of the check to assist us in keeping an accurate record of your account.
 - d. A late fee of **\$25.00** will be applied the following Monday.
 - e. If you do not pay on Friday and do not pay the late fee Monday, summer camp for your child will be canceled.
5. **LOST AND FOUND:**
 - a. **Will be donated every Friday.**
6. **WE ARE NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR LOST OR STOLEN ITEMS.**
 - a. The less your child brings to camp, the less they have to lose.
7. **BELONGINGS:**
 - a. Please write your child's name on their uniform, clothes, and any other personal items that they bring to camp.
8. **REFERRAL REWARDS PROGRAM:**
 - a. For each new student you bring in that signs up, YOUR child will receive a \$50.00 gift card to our pro shop.
9. Re-read #4.
10. Yes, I mean you. 😊

Together, we can make Summer Camp a fun and exciting experience for everyone!

Special Activities

Parks – Cypress forrest, Wood Gate Park, Anderson Park, Crest Lake Park, or Philippe Park, weather permitting. We will go to a park for lunch and games.

Bowling – We will go bowling once a week at Countryside Lanes.

Movies – We will go to the awesome Cobb movie theater once a week or rent a movie to watch at the dojang. The children will choose movies with parent's permission.

Swimming – We will go to the pool once a week for swimming and outdoor activities. If your child cannot swim, or you do not want your child to swim that day, dry land games will be available. Children are responsible for bringing their own towel, sunscreen and change of clothes.

Board Breaking – We will have a board-breaking contest to enhance the skills and confidence of the students.

Celebration Station – One of the favorites for the children! Please provide money for the children on this day. Older children only will be permitted to take part in the activities outside.
