- Wells and more!

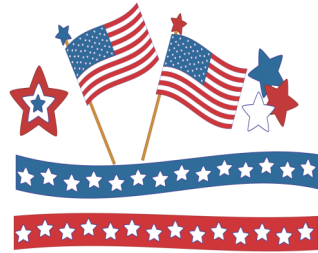

## EMERGENCY BYPASS

We have had some recent instances of calling parents whose phones are on Do Not Disturb. Please set up our phone number to allow Emergency Bypass. This allows your phone to ring from our number even though it is on Do Not Disturb.

Instructions for iPhone: Open Contacts, Select a contact, then tap Edit, Tap Ringtone or Text Tone, then turn on Emergency Bypass.

Instructions for Android: Open the quick settings panel by swiping down from the top of the screen using two fingers. Tap and hold the do not disturb icon to open up its settings. Swipe to the "Allowed during Do not disturb section", then tap "Calls and messages" to add exceptions. Go through your contact lists and select exceptions.

## *Welcome, Summer!*

*Here are a few housekeeping items for new students and reminders for continuing students.*

Make sure to sign-in and sign-out for your child by scanning the QR code with the Childpilot app. Authorized pick up persons can also get a Childpilot account. Request an account via the office.

Take your water bottle home every day to be cleaned. Return every morning filled with fresh water.

At pick up and drop off, please turn off your car engine and bring your purse/ valuables with you. It only takes a second for someone to steal your car or your purse while your back is turned.

If your child will be absent, please email the office or mark your child absent on Childpilot by 10 a.m.

If your child needs sunblock, you may leave it at school. Make sure to label with his/her name. It's best to apply before coming to school, and then our teachers can reapply in the afternoon.

To communicate with your child's teacher, message via Childpilot or email. If you need to meet with the teacher, please schedule an appointment.

### Summer Camp Students:

Field trips are for ages 5 and over. For safety reasons, you must have the light blue school t-shirt in order to go. T-shirts may be purchased at the office for \$15.
