- Extracurricular classes*

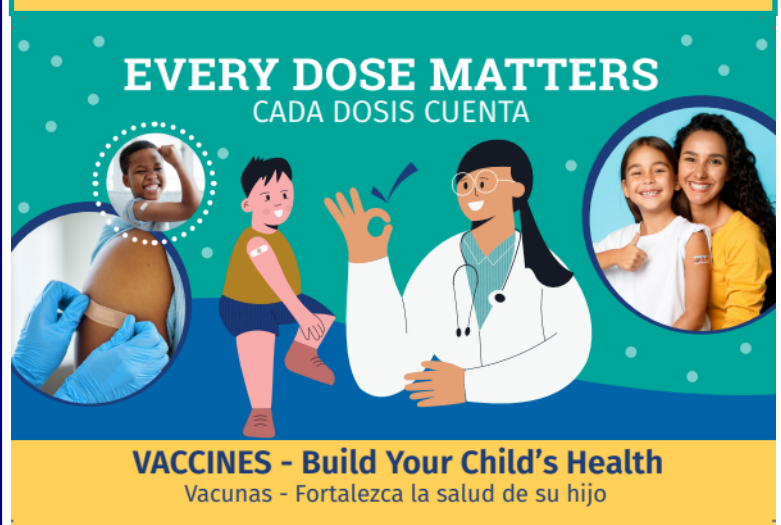
Referrals

BACK TO SCHOOL

After Schoolers:

If you will not need pick-up, please notify the office by 2pm either by email, phone call, or Childpilot message. (Do not leave voicemail.) A no-show fee of \$5 will be charged if you do not notify us of your child's absence.

Please drop your child/ren off prior to 9:00 am. Drop-offs during instruction time (9:00-11:30) are very disruptive and distracting to teachers and students already engaged in their work. If your child will arrive after 9:00 due to an appointment or unexpected delay please message the office. Drop-offs are not allowed during our rest period of 12:00-2:30 pm. Please make arrangements to drop off before or after those hours. If your child will be absent please message the office by 9:00 am.

Uniforms

Now that summer is over, we will be enforcing uniforms starting 8/11.

Have your child wear their navy polo shirt with khakis Mondays–Thursdays and the light blue school t-shirt with jeans or khakis on Fridays.

If you need more, or a larger size, polo shirts are \$20, t-shirts are \$15. For cooler weather, long-sleeve polos are \$24 and sweat-shirts are \$25.

Label all items

Label or write your child's name on their water bottles and clothing. We have many of the exact same water bottles and blankets.

Medications

At no time may medications be brought into the child's classroom in his/her lunch bag or backpack. Please send medication to school only when imperative. Ask your physician to prescribe dosage times other than school hours if possible. The Medication Authorization in the office must be signed by the parents.

Check-in / check-out

Parents must check their children in and out each day. This allows our teachers to have accurate count of the students in their class.

Nut-free school

We are a nut-free school due to students' severe allergies. Do not send peanut butter sandwiches, trail mix snacks, or nut candies to school.
