Weekend Chinese School will begin the weekend of January 13. If you would like more information or wish to register, please contact the office. Ms. Linda can assess your child's appropriate level and let you know the date/ time of your child's class.

#### **Christmas holiday school closure**

Please note these holiday closures and early release dates:

Our school will close early at 3pm on Friday, 12/22.

We will be closed from 12/25-1/2 inclusive, and will reopen on January 3. One week of tuition will not be charged for the week 12/25-12/29.

#### **Holiday Drop-in**

We do realize some parents will need to work during that time and have no other child care options. While our location will closed 12/25-12/29, the Allen location will be open from 12/26-12/29, 7:00 am-6:00 pm for drop-in care. (There will be early release on 12/29 at 12 noon.) Inform your school office if you need drop-in care at our Allen school.

Preschool drop-in rate is \$85/day (under 3yrs), \$60/day (over 3yrs). K-5 drop-in rate is \$55/ day. Please inform us by 12/20 if you will need drop-in care.

(If you are with CCA North Central Texas, you can contact your caseworker to temporarily switch to Allen for one week. Our Allen school is not with CCA Dallas.)
