<u>Instructions for iPhone</u>: Open Contacts, Select a contact, then tap Edit, Tap Ringtone or Text Tone, then turn on Emergency Bypass.

Instructions for Android: Open settings. Search for Do Not Disturb. Scroll down to the "Allowed" during Do not disturb section, then tap "Calls" to add exceptions. Go through your contact lists and select exceptions.
