ULTREYA**SCHEMA OF THE ULTREYA**

The systematics of the meeting of Ultreya breaks with all the traditional molds of “pious” meetings.

1ST PERIOD: ARRIVAL – GROUP REUNIONS

As people arrive at the agreed place and time, they spontaneously group together in small groups of three to six people, who deliberately seek to be different each week, trying to bring together in the group someone they know and others that they do not know.

They proceed, “after invoking the Holy Spirit” by any one of them, to communicate the achievements, the difficulties and the plans that each one of them has experienced in their life during the last week, with the same outline that they use in their Friendship group reunion, but undoubtedly less in-depth and detailed, in a total time of one-half hour.

2ND PERIOD: ROLLO (EXPERIENTIAL)

Then everyone is invited to a room, where a layperson assumes the role of “Rector” - as in the Cursillo, and asks the person who is doing the first “talk” of the week, to express his experience, for 15 or 20 minutes, and then asks four or five people to echo or resonate the “talk” in interventions that usually do not exceed two minutes per person.

The priest makes a final intervention, to “center” theologically and doctrinally of what they shared.

The “rector” of the Ultreya makes the announcements of the Movement that he believes are of general interest.

3RD PERIOD: CHAPEL (JOINT VISIT)

The third period is in the Chapel, a “farewell visit” is made of all before the Tabernacle, directed by the Rector or by another layperson, in which the speaker communicates out loud to the Lord what he considers most essential to be heard, and conveys the prayer petitions for specific intentions that the attendees have requested, ending with the Our Father and the Hail Mary.

At the end, they sing De Colores!
