- **Registered animals shall have papers present.**
- **ALL exhibits must be pre-entered. NO day of entries will be permitted. Animals must be in place one hour before start of show on the day of the show and will be released following the show. Pen space is on a first come, first serve basis. All others will be permitted to show out of their trailers, in designated area.**
- **Best udder cow in Lot 18 will receive show day milk check.**
